

#### Phil's Forecast:

Boise St trails all-time series 4-2 incl ATS losses in '12 & '19 Las Vegas Bowl. Last mtg in '23, Washington (-14) won 56-19. Michael Penix threw 5 td passes and the Huskies held Ashton Jeanty and the ground gm to 138 yds. UW playing in a bowl for the 4th straight yr and 2nd under HC Jedd Fisch. They lost 35-34 in LY's Sun Bowl to Louisville (+1'). They outgained the Cards 472-371 and QB Demond Williams had breakout 5 td gm. Since '02, the only time Boise St missed bowl was when gm was cancelled in '18, '20 & '21. Broncos on 0-4 ATS bowl slide incl 0-2 under HC Spencer Danielson ('23 LA Bowl/'24 Fiesta Bowl) and last covered a bowl in '17. After making the CFP last yr, Boise took a step back in '25 and really missed Heisman finalist Jeanty. They opened with a 34-7 loss to USF, won 3 straight as a DD favorite then lost to ND 28-7. Broncos rallied for 3 more wins, but third year starting QB Maddux Madsen (58%, 21-7) was injured and the offense tanked in b2b losses to Fresno St and SD St. With Max Cutforth filling in and getting more comfortable, Boise closed the reg ssn with 3 wins in a row to qualify for the MW championship gm vs UNLV. Madsen returned and Boise rolled, 38-21, for their 3rd straight league title over the Rebs. There's no one of Jeanty's caliber, but Dylan Riley and Sire Gaines have combined for 1886 yds (5.6) and 18 td's. The D holds opp 64 ypg below their avg (#26 FBS) and the pass D ranks 17th in the country with ratio of 13-14. Washington was far more experienced in Fisch's 2nd ssn and improved from 6 reg ssn wins to 8. The Huskies won gms they were supposed (6-3 ATS as fav) but couldn't break through as a dog (SU & ATS losses to Ohio St, Michigan, Oregon) and fell at Wisconsin Nov. 8, 13-10. Williams had a breakout 1st ssn as a starter (70%, 21-8, 595 rush) and UW has the better skill talent. But RB Jonah Coleman & WR Denzel Boston are banged up juniors with NFL futures which could mean more reps for RB Adam Mohammed (517, 5.0) and WR Dezmen Roebuck (554, 13.5). Huskies hold opp 48ypg below their avg and have a big edge in run D (104 ypg, 3.4 ypc). Michigan & Wisconsin are the only tms to rush for more than 100 yds against UW. Boise is 0-2 ATS as a dog this year and 1-2 under Danielson. My computer has Washington 32-21 and my AGG has the Huskies by 7.9. Washington has played the tougher schedule (#41 vs #76) and has the better STs (#63 vs #105). Against the toughest opponents on the schedule, both of these tms came up short in '25. However, the Broncos did well to win another MWC and are a better overall team with Madsen under center. Williams and the tough run defense will lead Washington to a win, but the veteran Broncos will keep the game within single digits.

## **Phil's Forecast:**

The Celebration Bowl is played between the winners of the MEAC and the SWAC and is played in Atlanta at the Mercedes Benz Stadium. SC State is playing in their 3rd Celebration Bowl. The Gamecocks won this game in '21 when they beat Jackson St 31-10. Last year was a rematch vs Jackson St and they lost 28-7. PV A&M won their first SWAC Title since 2009 and this is their first Celebration Bowl.SCSt went 9-3 and won the MEAC in Chennis Berry's first year. They had 7 starters back including just 2 on offense but were still considered a contender in the MEAC. They started 2-3 but two of their 3 losses were vs FBS teams and they had a 449-345 yd edge in their loss to Charleston Southern. SCSt won their next 7 games including over Delaware St in the finale that decided the conference title. QB Billy Atkins is a James Madison transfer that led the Dukes to a bowl win over WKU last year. He has started the last 7 games and has a 17-4 ratio. Their D is holding foes 25 ypg below their avg. On offense they are putting up 35 ypg more than foes allow. SCSt is #2 in our FCS Pass D rankings (48%, 19-14) led by CB Jarod Washington (2 int, 20 pbu's). A&M went 5-7 last year and made a change, bringing in Tremaine Jackson who had success at Valdosta St. The Panthers were competitive in early losses to UTRGV and Rice. They won 5 straight before a 3 pt loss to Alabama St. A&M won their last 3 reg ssn games to clinch a berth in the SWAC Title game then upset Jackson St 23-21 last week. Their Oline is the strength of the tm. A&M avg 203 rush ypg (5.6) and they've allowed just 7 sacks. Their D holds foes 37 ypg below their avg. LB Kennedy Parker leads the team with 14.5 tfl's. A&M is #8 in our pass D rankings (52%, 7-8). SCSt has the location edge but A&M's fans will be excited for their first Celebration Bowl. The computer has PV A&M 31-25 but AGG has SCSt by 1. There is some concern for a letdown from A&M after they won the SWAC but Jackson is a good coach and will have them focused. Panthers win a close game by a fg.

## **Phil's Forecast:**

First meeting. Old Dominion is back in the postseason after going 5-7 and missing last year. Monarchs are after their 2nd bowl win and first since '16. They beat EMU (+5'), 24-20, in the Bahamas Bowl. Under HC Ricky Rahne, they're 0-2 SU & ATS losing the '21 Myrtle Beach Bowl to Tulsa (-8'), 30-17, and the '23 Famous Toastery Bowl to WKU (+6'), 38-35, in OT. This is USF's 3rd straight bowl gm. Bulls won and covered in '23 & '24 with wins over Syracuse & San Jose St. This is interim HC Kevin Patrick's 1st gm at the helm. He's been the team's DL coach since '23. After b2b 7-6 seasons, USF exploded out of the gate in '25 with upsets of Boise St at home and Florida in the Swamp to rise to #18 in the AP. After a loss to #5 Miami, Bulls got back on track with 4 straight blowouts and were heavily favored to grab the G5 playoff berth. However, they stumbled twice on the road down the stretch, at Memphis and at Navy, and didn't even qualify for the league title gm. After going 9-3 (best ssn since `17) and averaging 43ppg, 3rd yr HC Alex Golesh took the Auburn job. The star and catalyst was QB Byrum Brown (67%, 32-7, 1008 rush) but he is sitting this game out. Senior Gaston Moore (14-20-54-1/0) will start and he's been in Golesh's system his entire career from UCF to Tennessee and here. They also have touted frosh Locklan Hewlett (PS #64). The defense is solid in the front 7 (3.6 ypc, 32 sacks) but beatable through the air against better passers. Miami, North Texas, Memphis & UTSA dinged the DB's for more than 300 yds. ODU is also off a breakout season, going 9-3 for its most wins since `16. Rahne's 6th team in Norfolk was by far his best and most experienced. Monarchs only lost by 13 to Big Ten champ Indiana in the opener and then ripped off 4 straight wins by DD including at Va Tech which got Brent Pry fired. They hit a midseason snag with b2b blowout road losses to Marshall and JMU (-7 combined TO's) but rebounded for 5 wins in a row. ODU's version of Brown was QB Colton Joseph (60%, 21-10, 1007 rush) but he has opted out and is looking to transfer. Redshirt frosh Quinn Henicle gets his 2nd career start. In his 1st start in `24, he was the SBC POW after rushing for 206 yds and accounting for 4 td's ir a 40-32 win at Arkansas St. The defense held the last 5 reg ssn opp below their avg and gave up just 9ppg in those wins. My computer has USF 36-22 and my AGG favors the Bulls by 7.8 but those projections don't factor opt outs and coaching changes. Bulls have faced the tougher schedule (#73 vs #97) and have a huge STs edge (#28 vs #119). As a favorite this year, USF 5-2-1 ATS. As a dog, ODU is 2-1 this year and 23-14-1 under Rahne. Both teams are after 10 wins, a particularly big deal for ODU. USF lost its coach, OC and QB while ODU lost their QB but Henicle won't be the drop-off many expect him to be, and this could be his big showcase chance before `26. With Brown out ODU is a live dog considering the QB edge would actually shift to Henicle and the Monarchs.

### Phil's Forecast:

First meeting between these schools. This is Louisiana's 2nd trip to the 68 Ventures Bowl, a game they won in '20 over UTSA. The Cajuns have lost all 3 bowl games under HC Michael Desormeaux (0-1-2 ATS). Delaware is playing in a bowl in its FBS debut. Blue Hens were supposed to be ineligible in Year 1 but that was waived when not enough schools were bowl eligible. This game is a big deal for the entire program and the fan base. Delaware does have postseason experience, though, having reached the FCS playoffs under HC Ryan Carty in '21, '22 and '23. Louisiana won 10 games last season before losing the Sun Belt title game and the New Mexico Bowl to TCU (-10), 34-3. They returned just 7 starters this season. Cajuns overcame a 2-6 start to win the final 4 games and qualify for this trip to Mobile. The clincher was a 30-27 win over instate rival ULM in which they allowed 516 total yards. QB Lunch Winfield was injured in the game but is expected to be okay. He's provided a spark since coming off the bench in the Marshall win and has accounted for 18 td's and 1,951 yards. Cajuns are -72ypg for the year and were -71ypg during the winning streak. They've found ways to get to 6-6 despite yielding 51ypg more than the opp average (#120 FBS). None of their regular season wins were over a team with a winning record. Under Carty, Delaware has made a smooth transition to CUSA. They're also 6-6 and were +37ypg and +1ppg in conference play. Those wins included upsets of UConn, FIU and Louisiana Tech. QB Nick Minicucci threw for 3,495 (63%, 22-7) and added 10 td's on the ground. They are +14 ypg against our #124 sked. The D allows 403 ypg and 33 ppg. They are allowing 29 ypg more than their foes avg (#98 FBS) but the offense puts up 19 ypg more than their foes allow (#61 FBS). RB Jo Silver (536, 5.1) has missed time with injuries, but he played 23 snaps in the finale and could be healthy after having a few weeks off. My computer has Louisiana 35-31 and my AGG has the Cajuns by 0.2 and 3.5 over the last 4 weeks. As a favorite this yr, Louisiana is 1-3 ATS and 8-14 ATS over the last 3 years. Delaware was 3-2-1 ATS as a favorite this year including those 3 outright upsets. I expect a close game, and I agree with the computer's call for plenty of points after Delaware finished the season with 61 points and Louisiana allowed 516 yards to a bad ULM offense. I'll go with my computer with a lean to the over.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

This is their 1st meeting as FBS members. Arkansas St is 2-0 vs Missouri St, winning the most recent game in '15, 70-7. This is the Red Wolves' 3rd straight bowl trip. They beat Bowling Green (-9) in LY's 68 Ventures Bowl, 38-31, and lost to NIU (+2') in '23 Camellia Bowl, 21-19. HC Butch Jones is 5-3 SU & 6-2 ATS all-time in bowls (1-1 ATS at ASU/3-0 at Tenn/1-0 at Cinc/1-1 at CMU). This is Missouri St's debut in the FBS and their first bowl gm. This is HC Ryan Beard's 1st postseason game overall. As a condition of joining the FBS, Missouri St was supposed to be ineligible for a bowl this season, but that was waived when there weren't enough teams to fill available slots. This is a really big deal for a school and a fan base that thought it had no shot of bowling in `25. The Bears have made a nice transition to C-USA, going 7-5 with road upsets over the Sun Belt's Marshall and conference foe Liberty. They had a 5-gm win streak, including 4 by 7pts or less, but finished with losses to Kennesaw and LT. The offense is in good hands with veteran QB Jacob Clark (65%, 24-11) and FIU transfer RB Shomari Lawrence (964, 5.3). However, their 44 sacks allowed rank 134th in the FBS! The D is coming off 2 of its worst games of the yr, allowing 387 passing to Kennesaw, 388 rushing to LT and 83 total pts in those losses. Despite their 6-6 record, Arkansas St has been scrappy all season. They only lost by 8 to Iowa St, 7 to Kennesaw St, and won 4 in a row after it looked like the ssn was slipping away at 1-4. In a do-or-die battle for bowl eligibility, they ended the regular ssn by beating App St, 30-29, on the road on a td with :42 left. The ground gm is poor, so the offense rests on QB Jalen Raynor (67%, 16-11) and 700+ yd receivers Corey Rucker & Chauncy Cobb. The D is a weakness, allowing 34ypg more than opp avg (#105 FBS), and Clark will go right after the 120th ranked pass D (17-7 ratio). ASU is 4th in SBC with 31 sacks, and expect All-Conference ends Ethan Hassler and Demarcus Hendricks to pin their ears back against the soft Missouri St blocking unit. As a favorite, Missouri St was 4-2 ATS this season. As a dog, Arkansas St was 6-2 ATS with 4 outright upsets! My computer has Arkansas St 27-25 but my AGG has Missouri St by 2.9. The Red Wolves have the better ST's (#35 vs #79). There is no doubt the Bears will be fired up for this programfirst bowl. And Clark is going to put up numbers against the porous ASU secondary. However, Arkansas St has the more experienced staff and better line play. They'll pressure Clark into mistakes in a game that will be very close and high scoring, so I have a small lean to the over.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

First meeting. This is a battle between the MAC and CUSA Champs. HC Jerry Mack did a phenomenal job turning KSU around in his 1st year on the job and the school's 2nd in the FBS. This is their first FBS bowl game. Western Michigan is making their first trip to the Myrtle Beach Bowl. The Broncos are just 2-8 SU but 5 5 ATS in bowls. Last year was HC Lance Taylor's first bowl and they lost to South Alabama 30-23 (+9'). KSU was picked to finish 11th in the preseason by the CUSA coaches. HC Mack built the roster with experienced lower-level guys, and it paid off. They nearly upset Wake Forest in the opener, losing 10-9, and after an 0-2 start they won 10 of their next 11 games. KSU lost at Jax St in the reg ssn meeting but rebounded and beat them in the CUSA Title game, 19-15. They are 10-3 SU/ATS but only +2 ypg despite playing our #133 sked. QB Amari Odom, who did not begin the year as the starter, came on to throw for 2385 with an 18-6 ratio (376, 7 td's rushing). Odom has a solid WR corps led by Gabriel Benyard (898, 16.3) and a location edge for fans who want to watch their first bowl game. The D allows 24ypg above opp average (#90 FBS) and gave up 236 rush ypg (5.7) over the final 4 weeks, a big concern against an opponent that rushed for 284 (4.5) in its final 4. Taylor has WMU bowling in b2b years. They were picked in the preseason to finish 7th but wound up winning their first MAC title since '16. Broncos opened 0-3 and trailed Toledo 13-0 in the 3Q but rallied for 14 13 upset win that turned the season around. They won 9 of their last 10 games including the MAC Title game in a revenge spot vs Miami, OH. They're 9-4 SU & 10-3 ATS incl 4 straight ATS wins to close out the regular season. WMU has a powerful ground game, led by RB Jalen Buckley (829, 4.8) and QB Broc Lowry who has rushed for 940 (4.8) and 14 td's. They have played the #108 sked and are +37 ypg. The defense has been outstanding all year. They hold opp 57ypg below their average (#29 FBS) and allow just 18ppg. They're #6 in FBS with 38 sacks, and DE Nadame Tucker leads the country with 14.5. WMU has a higher rated D at all 3 levels than KSU. My computer favors the Broncos in a low-scoring game, 22-17. AGG also gives the edge to WMU by 1.5 and 5.6 over the last 4 weeks. WMU has the better ST's (#49 vs #79) and has faced the tougher schedule (#105 vs #133). Under Taylor, Broncos are 16-4 ATS as a favorite (6-1 this yr)! KSU is 11-8 ATS as a dog since '23 and 3-1 this year with 2 outright upsets under Mack. WMU is the stronger overall team, and I like their physicality on both sides of the ball. They'll ride the ground game and the pass rush to a win and a cover over KSU.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

First meeting between schools. This game was previously known as the St. Petersburg Bowl and Beef O'Brady's Bowl. Memphis played in the first edition of this bowl in 2008, a 41-14 loss to USF. NC State won here in 2014, 34-27, over UCF. HC Ryan Silverfield left Memphis for Arkansas, so DB coach Reggie Howard is leading the team on an interim basis. Memphis has won 4 straight bowls (3-1 ATS). NC St has lost 4 straight bowls and HC Dave Doeren is 3-6 SU and 4-5 ATS in bowls, losing the Military Bowl LY to East Carolina (+7) 26-21. Memphis was the favorite to win the AAC and considered a strong CFP contender. Tigers opened 6-0 including a thrilling 32-31 win over Arkansas. QB Brendon Lewis missed their game at UAB (+21'), yet they lost a stunner in Birmingham 31-24. They rebounded with wins over USF and Rice but fell apart late in the season and lost their last 3 to finish a disappointing 8-4 SU & 7-5 ATS with 3 straight ATS losses to close the year. Memphis is +59 ypg and +28ypg in their last 4 despite the 3 losses. Lewis has thrown for 2,567 (70%, 15-6) and is their #2 rusher behind Sutton Smith with 613 (4.3). Their best OL, RT Travis Burke missed the finale and is questionable here for a struggling unit that ranks last in the American with 31 sacks allowed. The D allows just 3.7 ypc but ranks 57th in pass D and has just 18 sacks. NC St, on the other hand, started 3-0 but then lost 4 of their next 5 games. They won 3 of their last 4 to finish 7-5 & 6-6 ATS. Four of their losses were on the road vs ACC champ Duke, Notre Dame, Pitt and Miami. They beat GT, Virginia, Florida St and UNC at home, plus had a road win over Wake Forest. Pack is -26 ypg but did play our #34 toughest schedule. Balanced offense is led by OB CJ Bailey (70%, 2884, 23-9, 215 rush) and RB Hollywood Smothers (939, 5.9). They average 30ppg and gain 39ypg above opp avg (#42 FBS). The defense has underachieved this ssn especially against the pass. NC St allows opp to gain 34ypg above their avg (#104 FBS) and rank 90th in pass D (63%, 21-8). Like Memphis, the Pack DBs have been hurt by a lack of pressure and have just 18 sacks to rank 16th in the ACC. My computer has NC St 31-28 but gives Memphis the yardage edge 408-397. AGG also favors the Tigers by 5.4. The Wolfpack has played the much tougher schedule (#34 vs #87) and they have a big coaching edge with Doeren against an interim HC. Memphis has a big edge on ST's (#53 vs #126). Over the last 3 ssns, Memphis is 6-2 ATS as a dog incl 2-1 this yr with outright upsets of Arkansas and USF. Since '22, NC St is just 9-15 ATS as a favorite but 4-2 this ssn. NC St is the more motivated and the more stable team heading into this matchup. The Pack could have some key opt-outs on offense, but while they ended the yr with a 23-point win over rival UNC, Memphis collapsed and then lost their coach.

## **Phil's Forecast:**

Oklahoma has had the upper hand on Alabama lately, winning 5 of the last 6 meetings. This is a rematch of the Week 12 game won by Sooners (+6) in Tuscaloosa, 25-23. However, Bama actually had a 406-212 edge in yards but were done in by -3 TO's and an early pick-6 by CB Eli Bowen. In '24, OU was +14 yet won 24-3 in Norman. This is HC Brent Venables' first CFP game, while Tide HC Kalen DeBoer led Washington to the National Title Game against Michigan in '23. Bama got off to a brutal start when they were upset in the opener by Florida St, 31-17. However, they rebounded quickly and won their next 8 games including at Georgia and Vandy and Tennessee at home. Following the Oklahoma loss, they escaped Auburn in the Iron Bowl, 27-20, in a must-win situation. In the SEC CG rematch with Georgia, Tide had ssn-lows in points and yards (209) and lost in Atlanta, 28-7. QB Ty Simpson has thrown for 3268 with a 26-5 ratio but is only 5-4 in the last 4 games. RB Jam Miller (493, 4.0) has been banged up but is expected to return for this game. They'll need him because Bama averages just 116 rush ypg and 3.6 ypc! Simpson has 3 talened WR's in Germie Bernard, Ryan Williams, and Isaiah Horton. Tide averages 31ppg but have been below that # in their last 5 vs the FBS. The D holds opp 88ypg below their avg (#14 FBS) and have not allowed more than 28 pts since the opener in Tallahassee. Their ST's has been inconsistent, and K Conor Talty is just 13-20 on FG's this year. I considered Oklahoma to be a legit playoff contender before the season despite a tough schedule. They beat Michigan as part of a 5-0 start, but QB John Mateer was injured Week 4 vs Auburn. He returned for Texas but was clearly not 100% and the Sooners lost 23-6. Two wks later, they gave up a ssn high 34 pts in a loss to Ole Miss. However, facing CFP do-or-die every week, they won their final 4 including road upsets over Tennessee and Bama. Mateer hasn't been the playmaker he was expected to be when he transferred from Wazzu (62%, 12-10, 416 rush). Sooners only rush for 124 (3.7) and have allowed 24 sacks. In SEC play, they average 22ppg and are -17ypg. The defense, though, is elite. Venables' unit allows just 274ypg and is holding foes 112 ypg below their avg (#7 FBS). A dominant front 7 is holding tms to 2.5 ypc and is tied for the FBS lead with 41 sacks. Leading sacker R Mason Thomas, who missed the final 2 gms, was not listed on this week's injury report. My computer has Oklahoma winning a low-scoring 21-15 rock fight. AGG has the Sooners by 1.5. Bama has faced the tougher sked (#7 vs #20) but OU has the better ST's (#21 vs #44). As a single digit favorite, Bama is 3-2-1 ATS under HC DeBoer. This is just the 3rd time Oklahoma has been a home dog since '16! Under HC Venables, they are 4-5 ATS as a single digit dog (2-1 this yr with outright upsets of Tenn/Bama). Alabama has the better offense, but Oklahoma has the better D. The Sooners have home field while the Tide has double-revenge for losses the last 2 meetings. Bama was the better team in November despite the 2-point loss. I think they do a better job of protecting the ball and get payback with a close and hard-fought road win.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

First meeting. James Madison is in the College Football Playoff in just its 4th season as an FBS member. This is their 3rd straight year qualifying for the postseason. They lost to Air Force (+1') in '23, 31-21, and beat Western Kentucky (+7), 27-17, LY in HC Bob Chesney's debut. Chesney took Holy Cross to the FCS playoffs from '19-'23 so he has experience preparing teams for win or go home gms. Oregon has missed the postseason just 2 times this century, '04 under Mike Bellotti and '16 under Mark Helfrich. Top-ranked Ducks lost in the CFP quarterfinals (Rose Bowl) last yr to eventual national champ Ohio St, 41-21. HC Dan Lanning is 2-1 SU & 1-2 ATS in the postseason. JMU is 12-1 SU & 8-5 ATS after steamrolling through the Sun Belt. Dukes only loss was at the ACC's Louisville, 28-14, in a game they led in the 2H and could have won. Cards had just 264 yds and were +1 yd. JMU has outscored its opponents by an avg of 37-16 and 201ypg. However, their best wins are over Old Dominion and Washington St, so this is a massive step up in weight class. Chesney built this team on defense and the rushing attack. RB Wayne Knight is an all-purpose star who's rushed for 1263 yds (6.6) and has 37 rec for 379 yds. QB Alonza Barnett is a dual threat with 2533 passing (60%, 21-8) and 544 rushing (4.7). The passing gm ranks 94th and the offense will struggle when the run gm stumbles. The D, on the other hand, is elite. JMU holds opp 137 ypg below their avg (#2 FBS!) and have not allowed more than 28 pts in a gm all year. Dukes allow just 2.5 ypc and 49.5% completions which is #3 in the FBS. This is an SBC defense that plays at a P4 level. Chesney has accepted the UCLA job but will remain with JMU until their playoff run ends. #5 Oregon is the highest rated at-large team. They're also 12-1, only losing to #1 Indiana in Eugene, 30-20. At home, Ducks win by average of 42-14 and 223 ypg. QB Dante Moore has had a solid debut with 2733 yds and 24-6 ratio. His receivers have been banged up all year, but TE Kenyon Sadiq (490, 12.6) is a star and a future high NFL draft pick. The trio of RB's Noah Whittington, Jordon Davison, and Dierre Hill all avg over 6 ypc. The Oregon D is the best unit JMU will see all yr. Ducks hold opp 121ypg below their avg (#4 FBS) and give up only 3.2 ypc. The pass D is also terrific, ranking #4 with a 12-13 ratio. There are no areas of Lanning's D that JMU can exploit. Both Oregon coordinators have taken HC jobs but will coach in the CFP. Under Lanning, Ducks 18-9 ATS at home and 14-7 ATS when laying 20+ pts. JMU has covered 3 straight as an AD, the last 2 under Chesney. The Dukes have not been this big of a dog since '16. My computer calls for Oregon to win 36-14. My AGG has the Ducks by 20.1. Oregon has the better ST's (#26 vs #45) and a massive edge in schedule strength (#13 vs #102). JMU has been a great story, and they might be this year's best G5 team. But Oregon at Autzen is completely out of their league. With a big size and physicality advantage, Ducks will stack the box to stop Knight and Barnett, and from there it'll be lights out for the offense. The JMU defense will keep things from getting completely out of control, but I agree with my computer that the Ducks will overpower the Dukes and win going away.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

These former SEC rivals have met 72 times. Ole Miss leads series 44-28 and has won 12 straight and covered the last 3 including Week 4 this yr. This will be the first College Football Playoff gm for both schools. This is the Rebels' 6th straight ssn in the postseason (3-2 SU & ATS) but 1st gm as a HC for Pete Golding who was elevated from DC after Lane Kiffin left for LSU. Since '18, Tulane only missed the postseason in '21. HC Jon Sumrall is 1-1 SU & ATS in bowls, losing LY in the Gasparilla Bowl to Florida, 33-8, who he'll be coaching in 26. Tulane is riding its best 4-yr run in program history. Sumrall has maintained what Willie Fritz built from 16-'23. The Green Wave is 11-2 and just slowed down UNT for their 2nd American title since 22. Mean Green leads FBS in scoring but only scored ssn-low 21 points. Tulane lost at UTSA, which is almost unbeatable in San Antonio, but also fell to Ole Miss, 45-10, on Sept 20. They were outgained by 266 yds and the QBs were 10-29 for 104 yds. They also allowed ssn-highs in rushing (241 yds) and total yds (548). Green Wave has beaten Northwestern, Duke and UNT but those were all in New Orleans. On the road, they're 4-2 SU & 3-3 ATS while going -2 ppg and -8 ypg. QB Jake Retzlaff (62%, 14-6, 610 rush) is an average passer, so the run game must produce for the offense to be effective. Tulane's strength is the defense. They hold opp 31ypg below their average (#43 FBS), allow just 3.5 ypc, and lead the American with 34 sacks. At 11-1, Ole Miss is having one of its best seasons ever, but they no longer have their architect, Kiffin. Golding was DC for 3 yrs and previously was Bama's DC, so he has plenty of big game experience. Rebels' only loss was at Georgia, 43-35, in a gm they were outgained 510-351. Their best win was at #8 Oklahoma. At home, Ole Miss is 8-0 SU & 4-4 and +23ppg and +233ypg. The offense gains 142 ypg above opp avg (#1 FBS!) led by OB Trinidad Chambliss (66%, 18-3) and Missouri transfer RB Kewan Lacy (1279, 5.0). Chambliss led Ferris St to the D2 National Championship, so he knows about playoff stakes and atmosphere. The D can be beaten but it takes a balanced attack which Tulane does not have. The Rebels are softer against the run (4.3 ypc) than the pass (182 ypg, 13-7 ratio). Since '20, Ole Miss is 21-19-1 ATS at home and 18-13-1 as a DD favorite. Tulane is 7-4 as an AD since '21 (along with Ole Miss loss this yr, upset Memphis as 3'pt dog). Green Wave on an 0-4 ATS slide as a DD dog. My computer is calling for Ole Miss to win 35-18 and the AGG favors the Rebels by 19.5. Tulane has the better ST's (#7 vs #34) but Ole Miss has faced the tougher schedule (#55 vs #71). The offense might miss Kiffin, but the team will play with something to prove to the coach that left them for another SEC school. The Rebels, with a fired-up fan base behind them, will play with 60 mins of passion, especially on defense against 1-dimensional Tulane. However, the Green Wave D will play much better than the first meeting which is why I'm leaning to Tulane with the points and under the total.

#### Phil's Forecast:

These schools will compete as Pac-12 foes beginning next season. Washington St leads the series 3-2, losing 26-23 in '21 and winning 49-28 in '24 behind 5 TD's from current Oklahoma QB John Mateer. The Cougars are on a 4-game bowl losing skid but did cover LY's Holiday Bowl in a 52-35 loss to Syracuse. Interim HC Jesse Bobbit has taken over for Jimmy Rogers who has replaced Matt Campbell at Iowa St. Utah St played in the '23 Potato Bowl and lost to Georgia St 45-22. This is HC Bronco Mendenhall's first bowl game since '19. He's 7-7 SU & 8-6 ATS going back to his days at BYU and Virginia.

Mendenhall is off to a good start at Utah St, adding 2 wins to a team that was 4-8 in '24. The Aggies are also 10-2 ATS (4-1 as fav), covering against Texas A&M and Vandy and losing by just 1 to MWC champ Boise St. heir only ATS losses were road games at Hawaii and New Mexico. This year's improvement has been led by an offense that averages 32 ppg and gains 44ypg above opp avg (#37 FBS). The sparkplug is QB Bryson Barnes who leads with 733 rushing and has thrown for 2687 (60%, 18-4). However, his top target Brandon Pegan is in the portal which means an even bigger role for Brady Boyd (644, 15.3). The defense allows 46ypg more than opp avg (#117 FBS) and gave up 23 td passes but did shave 10ppg and 46ypg off last year's numbers. Rogers also had a solid 1st season but used that success to land the Iowa St job. This is Bobbit's 1st gm at the helm. His D is a huge reason Wazzu is 6-6 and 8-4 ATS (5-2 as a dog). Cougars lost by just 9 combined pts to Ole Miss, Virginia and SBC champ JMU, and did not lose a gm by more than 4pts over the final 2 months of the reg ssn. In stark contrast to Utah St, they win with defense. WSU holds opp 99ypg below their avg (#12 FBS) and has allowed just 12.5 ppg over the last 8 weeks! However, the offense ranks 121st at 315ypg and averages just 22ppg. Cougs have just 36 plays of 20+ yds (#128 FBS) so they're unlikely to stretch the Aggie defense. The offense runs through QB Zevi Eckhaus who's thrown for just 1760 (12-9 ratio, 337 rush). My computer has Washington St 23-21. AGG favors Wazzu by 2.9 but Utah St by 2.0 for the last 4 weeks. Cougars have the edge in 57's (#69 vs ±108) and schedule (#64 vs ±75). Utah St's offense vs Bobbit's D is a very good early bowl matchup. Both tms are battle-tested vs the P4 and looking to finish this ssn over .500. Aggies have the edge and stability in the 2 most important areas, QB and HC. This is Mendenhall's 15th bowl as HC and Bobbit's 1st. Barnes will engineer the 2H drives to pull out an Aggie win in a close and competitive game.

This is the 9th meeting between these programs but just the first since 1981. After a decade on the sidelines HC Jason Candle has left for UConn. QB coach Robert Weiner is the interim HC and the Huskies have already hired Mercer's Mike Jacobs to take over in '26. Last yr, Rockets (+6') upset Pitt 48-46 for their 1st ever win over the ACC, and the underdog has covered in Toledo's last 6 bowl trips. Louisville HC Jeff Brohm is 5-2 SU 8 4-3 ATS in bowls. Last yr, Cardinals defeated Washington 35-34 despite significant opt outs including their starting QB. Louisville has won 3 straight over the MAC but has dropped L/2 ATS incl this year's Week 4 win over Bowling Green (+26'), 40-17. On paper, Toledo was the MAC's top team this year. Rockets only lost to Kentucky by 8 in their opener. They blew a 13-0 lead at eventual league champ Western Michigan and a 21-0 lead at BG as a 10-pt favorite. Their only other loss was at Washington St. Toledo won their last 4 games to finish 8-4 SU & 9-3 ATS but lost tiebreaker for the MAC Title game to Miami, OH despite a head-to-head win. Toledo averages 32 ppg and 422 ypg, and they are +174 ypg. They're led by the veteran trio of QB Tucker Gleason (2515, 65%, 21-9), RB Chin Trayanum (950, 5.7) and WR Junior Vanderdoss (947, 12.6). The O-line has allowed just 13 sacks. On D, the Rockets rank #4 in the FBS at 12ppg and #3 at 249 ypg, though that was against one of CFB's weakest schedules. They allow just 2.6 ypc and are #22 in pass D with an 11-13 ratio. Louisville opened 4-0 but they were not impressive in the opening month. James Madison held the Cards to 264 yds and they had to rally back from a 17-pt deficit to defeat Pitt. A week later, they had a 383-237 yd edge at Virginia but lost by a fg. They upset Miami on the road the following week and were in the mix for the ACC Title game at 7-1, but they lost 3 straight to slip to 7-4. They were down to a walk-on RB and missing other key starters yet still pounded instate rival Kentucky 41-0 to reach 8-4 SU but 4-8 ATS. Cards are +89 ypg and have outscored opponents by an avg of 30-21. OB Miller Moss (64%, 2526, 14-7) plans to play but there's still uncertainty about the health/status of the RB's. We do top WR Chris Bell (917, 12.7) is out with a torn ACL. The D allows just 21 ppg and 300 ypg and holds foes 79 ypg below their avg (#18 FBS) Cards have the #20 pass D and have been especially tough against the run (6 opp held under 100 yds). My computer gives a 23-21 edge to Louisville and AGG has them at +4.8. They've played the much tougher schedule (#53 vs #127) and have one of the top ST's units (#5 vs #33). Toledo was a solid dog under Candle the last 5 yrs, going 6-1 ATS. In 3 ssns under Brohm, Louisville is 12-15 ATS under Brohm (just 3-7 this yr). This is a tough spot because there's so much opt-out uncertainty on both sides and Toledo is without Candle or the first time in a decade. I'll go with my computer and give a very cautious lean to Toledo plus the points

#### **Phil's Forecast:**

Western Kentucky has won all 4 meetings played from `12-'20. The Hilltoppers have bowled in all 7 seasons under HC Tyson Helton. They are 4-2 SU & 3-3 ATS including a 44-23 New Orleans Bowl win over South Alabama (-3') in '22. This is Southern Miss' first bowl since '22. Veteran Blake Anderson has replaced Charles Huff (Memphis) as HC. He was Huff's OC this season. Anderson is 3-6 SU & ATS in bowls and coached Arkansas St to a New Orleans Bowl loss in '15. Helton is 56-36 here but has yet to get over the hump and wir a CUSA title. This year's 8-4 team (9-3 ATS) had a new look incl just 2 returning starters on defense. The Hilltoppers went 3-1 in non-conf and won their 1st 2 CUSA games before being stunned by FIU (+10) in game QB Maverick McIvor threw 3 INT's and then was lost to an injury. He hasn't played since. WKU rallied for 3 wins and only lost at LSU by 3 but dropped a 37-34 heartbreaker to Jax St in the regular ssn finale to miss out on a league title berth. Frosh Rodney Tisdale stepped in at QB and flashed potential with 1367 yds and 9-6 ratio. However, the offense gains just 10ypg above opp avg (#72 FBS) and was inconsistent all year. The D, though, is a much bigger concern, allowing 5.1 ypc and lacking havoc with just 16 sacks (last in CUSA) and 13 takeaways (next to last in CUSA). Huff led USM to a 6-win improvement before taking the Memphis job. However, Golden Eagles faded down the stretch with 3 late losses (0-4 ATS in Nov) to squander a shot at the SBC title game vs JMU. QB Braylon Braxton (65%, 23-7) missed the 1st loss against Texas St, but he started the next 2 losses. The D fell apart with 4 straight gms over 400 yds allowed and allows 30 ypg above opp avg (#99 FBS). USM's best win is over the CUSA's Jax St, 42-25, who WKU lost to. Unlike WKU, Eagles create defensive chaos with 26 sacks and 26 TO's (#1 FBS with 21 INT's!). Six different Eagles have multiple picks while WKU has turned it over 18 times to rank 96th in the FBS. My computer has WKU 27-26 and my AGG has Hilltoppers by 1.3. WKU has the better ST's (#64 vs #89) while USM has slight schedule edge (#118 vs #129). Eagles just a 2-hour drive from New Orleans so they should have a crowd edge. Under Helton, WKU is 29-23-1 ATS as a favorite (6-2 this yr). Since '20 USM is 18-27 ATS as a dog (1-2 this yr). Anderson is a veteran HC so there'll be little drop-off for USM. In fact, his players will be extra motivated to impress the guy who'll be in charge in '26. Braxton has had time to get back to full strength, and rookie Tisdale vs the takeaway-happy USM DB's favors the Eagles. USM will win the line of scrimmage on D, so I think they have a shot to pull the outright upset in Anderson's debut as HC.

#### **Phil's Forecast:**

UNLV won the only previous meeting between these schools in '88. This is the Rebels' 3rd straight bowl game and 1st under HC Dan Mullen. They beat Cal (+3'), 24-13, in LY's LA Bowl. Mullen was 7-3 SU & 4-6 ATS in bowls while at Miss St and Florida. This is Ohio's 4th bowl in a row. Bobcats have won 6 straight dating back to '17 and are 5-1 ATS those games This is DC John Hauser's debut as interim HC. It's his 2nd year with the program after 8 seasons at Miami OH. Mullen has done a solid job of maintaining what Barry Odom built in Vegas. Despite significant roster turnover and new players from the portal, the Rebels are 10-3 (7-6 ATS) and made it to the MWC title gm. They were smoke and mirrors in the early going, getting outgained in 6 of the first 8 gms, but they gelled in November. Before losing to Boise in the league title gm, UNLV had won 4 straight by 22ppg and a struggling defense improved. Virginia transfer QB Anthony Colandrea is the face of the program, throwing for 3275 (66%, 23-8, 621 rush) after opening the yr as the backup. The skill guys include big-play RB Jai'Den Thomas (985, 7.2) and WR Jaden Bradley (869, 16.1). While the off avg 36ppg and 79ypg above the opp avg (#17 FBS) the D allows 53ypg above opp avg (#122 FBS). The Rebels give up 5.3 ypc and have allowed 23 td passes but were better in the 2nd half of the season. After winning their 1st MAC title since 1968, Ohio missed making the league champ gm this yr. New HC Brian Smith went 8-4 (6-6 ATS) but finished 1-4 ATS down the stretch incl a pivotal 17-13 loss at eventual MAC champ WMU. Earlier this month, Smith took a leave of absence which is why Hauser will be coaching here. Bobcats beat West Virginia and Miami OH, and all 4 losses came on the road. They've used a familiar blueprint of a north-south running gm and solid defense. QB Parker Navarro is a dual-threat senior (61%, 14-10, 839 rush) with bowl experience and Sieh Bangura leads the MAC in rushing with 1243 yds (5.6). The D only allows 23ppg but is more vulnerable than in '24, allowing 4.4ypc and 64% through the air. My computer has UNLV 35-27 and my AGG favors the Rebels by 1.8. The Rebels have the better ST's (#48 vs #96) and have faced the tougher schedule (#97 vs #116). UNLV is 15-6 ATS as a single digit favorite over the last 4 years (6-3 this yr). Over that same time, Ohio is 10-3 ATS as a single digit dog (1-0 this yr). The Bobcats have the culture to overcome Smith's absence, and they are very tough to beat in bowl games. I also like the matchup of their running game against a UNLV run D giving up 5+ ypc. I'll go against my computer and call for the outright upset as Ohio makes it 7 straight bowl wins.

Cal won the last mtg, 51-31, in Australia in `16. Nick Rolovich, a former Hawaii QB making his Warrior debut as HC in Sydney, is Cal's interim HC in this game. He coached in 3 Hawaii Bowls, going 2-1 SU & ATS. He was also the Washington St coach in '20 and part of '21. Rolovich and Hawaii HC Timmy Chang were teammates as QB's. This is Hawaii's first bowl gm since the '20 New Mexico Bowl win over Houston and Chang's 1st bowl as a coach. This is Chang's best and most experienced tm and they played like it, going 8-4 SU & ATS. In Honolulu, they're 6-1 SU & ATS and +15ppg and +103ypg. The Warriors already have an ACC win this ssn, beating Cal's rival Stanford in the opener 23-20. They also lit up San Diego St for 38 pts when the Aztec D looked unbeatable and was holding everyone under 10 pts. QB Micah Alejado has had a breakout 1st ssn as the starter with 2832 yds and a 21-9 ratio. After he returned from an early injury, UH gained more yds than the opposing D's avg in 7 of the final 8 gms. Top WR Jackson Harris (963, 19.6, 12 td's) has opted out and entered the portal so others like Pofele Ashlock (704, 11.4) will have to step up. The defense only allows

15ppg at home and both lines are better than Cal's units. Another mediocre ssn was enough for Cal to fire HC Justin Wilcox after 9 yrs. The Bears are 7-5 SU & 5-7 ATS. They started 3-0 then never won b2b games. Against common opponents, they lost to Stanford & SD St by 65-10 while Hawaii beat both 61-26. The bright spot in '25 was frosh QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele (PS#15) who grew up just 20 miles from the UH campus. He threw for 3117 (64%, 17-9) and will return in '26 to play for new HC Tosh Lupoi. In road games, Cal is 3-3 and -6ppg and -9ypg. In their worst losses, TO's were an issue. The Bears rank last in FBS rushing (76, 2.6) so this will be a battle of young lefty QB's, JKS vs Alejado. Defense, long a staple under Wilcox, really went south this yr. Cal allows 13ypg more than opp avg (#81 FBS) and was 13th in ACC sacks and 11th in TO's. They do have the better pass D (#37 vs #59) which will be a key factor in this matchup. My computer gives the edge to Hawaii, 26-24, and AGG favors the Warriors by 0.7. Cal has faced the much tougher schedule (#66 vs #113). As a home dog, Hawaii is 17-5-2 ATS since '20! Cal is 4-2 ATS in its last 6 as an AF (1-2 this yr with outright losses to SD St and Cal). This game matters to Rolovich and JKS who have deep Hawaii ties. And Cal's personnel match up evenly with Hawaii, especially with Harris out. But UH is a totally different team on the island and the common opponent comparison is telling. Alejado outduels JKS in a showcase of the gunslingers and the fact that Hawaii is getting points is a bonus.

### **Phil's Forecast:**

Villanova is the #12 seed and gets to host a semifinal after pulling 3 straight upsets to get here. Illinois St is the Missouri Valley's last hope. UC Davis had 25 yd td drive with 2:11 left and added garbage time td, as ISU won 42-31. ISU QB Tommy Rittenhouse has a 34-11 ratio and his top target, Daniel Sobkowicz has 992 (14.0) and 16 td's. Nova has won 11 straight. They destroyed Harvard 52-7 in the first round, escaped vs Lehigh despite getting outgained 339-235 then upset Tarleton St on the road last week. Nova trailed 14-0 1Q. It was 21-12 3Q, Nova got a 47 yd td run from RB Mace then went 78/12 td and led 26-21. Tarleton appeared to score the go-ahead td on 4th down late but the play was overturned and Nova won, with a 426-266 yd edge. QB Pat McQuaide has a 24-3 ratio. They have 3 RB's with over 680 rush yards! ISU has been gashed for over 200 rush in 3 games but also held NDSU to 59 rush (2.2). The computer has ISU by 1, but AGG has Nova by 5.7. Nova has the edge on offense and defense and they are at home and I'll take them in this spot to win and advance to the Title game.

The home team has covered the last 6 in this series. Montana is 12-1 SU/9-4 ATS, and they've covered their last 4. Last week we cashed a Best Bet on the Over in Montana's 52-22 win over #11 South Dakota. SD was coming off a 47-0 win over Mercer yet Montana led 24-0 2Q. Up 24-7, Montana got a 93 yd PR td and a 51 yd td pass. It was 38-7 4Q, SD scored two td's to get within 16 but Montana scored two td's in the last 2:40. OB Keali'I Ah Yat threw for 305 vds and 3 td's. He has a 7-0 ratio in playoff wins over SDSt and SD. RB Eli Gilman has 1,434 and 20 td's. He ran for 132 in the first meeting. Both Ah Yat and Gilman were 1st Team All-Big Sky. MSU started 0-2 this year, losing to Oregon and South Dakota St. They've bounced back by winning 12 straight (8-6 ATS this year). HC Vigen chewed the team out at midfield after their lackluster 21-13 win over Yale. Last week they led SF Austin 24-0 2Q. It was only 41-28 4Q, MSU added a fg with 1:52 left for a 16 pt win (-14.5). QB Lamson has a 22-3 ratio along with 661 rush (4.3). RB's Davis and Jones have combined for nearly 2,000 yards. S Caden Dowler leads the team with 6 int's and was named the Big Sky Defensive POY. The computer has MSU by 10 and AGG has MSU by 11.5 but L4W AGG has Montana by 5.3. Montana has had 8 of their last 12 games go Over the Vegas total. MSU just gave up 28 points and 344 yards to SF Austin. Montana has the slightly better offense while MSU has a huge edge on D, holding foes 76 ypg below their avg (#2 in FCS) while Montana allows 27 ypg more than their foes avg. The computer has 68 total points and the total is 56. We will call for MSU to win a close game and run it back with the Over in a Montana game for this week's best bet!
