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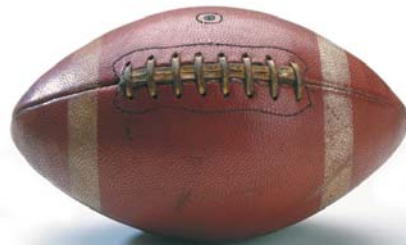

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AGAINST THE WIND

A Weekly Insight Into The Art Of Sports Handicapping

*Against the wind
We were runnin'
against the wind*

*We were young and strong;
we were runnin'
Against the wind*

Overall, the song's meaning is about getting older. It's about pushing on in life and maturing through love, exploration, heartbreak, and betrayal. The title and the repeated phrase "against the wind," in particular, signal the passing of time. The catchphrase itself came from Bob Seger's days of running track and cross country in high school when he would literally "run against the wind."

The song of the same name was one of his most popular tunes, a No. 3 best-seller, for good reason too. It's an unoffensive, almost hypnotic mid-tempo ballad with lyricism that inspired the next generation of singer/songwriters. (Garth Brooks, Brooks & Dunn, and The Highwaymen all did their own covers of the song.) In fact, Eagles' singer/songwriter Glenn Frey also provided backing vocals for the song. Seger and Frey met while

working in the Detroit music scene, where they both grew up.

The title of the song is also a perfect metaphor for struggling NFL teams that have slogged their way through mediocrity. But being value seekers that we are, it also becomes a profit-making situation if we...

PLAY ON any NFL home dog from Game 14 onward with a .250 or fewer win percentage if they won four or fewer games last season and they are facing an opponent whose team Net YPR is 0 or less.

And why not, as these face-in-the-wind teams are **27-9 ATS** this role since 1990. And if they are coming off a game in which they scored 10 or fewer points, they zoom up to **17-4 ATS**. That finds the **Cleveland Browns** in this role against Buffalo on Sunday.

Finally, bring the same opponent in off a game in which they failed to win by 6 or more points and they improve to **11-0 ATS** in this rare role.

Talk about going against the wind, the call goes out to the **Browns**, who will be going 'Against the Wind' this Sunday! With that, we'll

close out with what looks to be the perfect reminder from Seger's Silver Bullet Band:

*Against the wind
I'm still runnin' against the wind
Well I'm older now and still
Against the wind
It seems like yesterday
But it was long ago
And the secrets that we shared
The mountains that we moved
Caught like a wildfire
out of control
Till there was nothing left to burn
and nothing left to prove
Against the wind; baby, we're
running against the wind.*

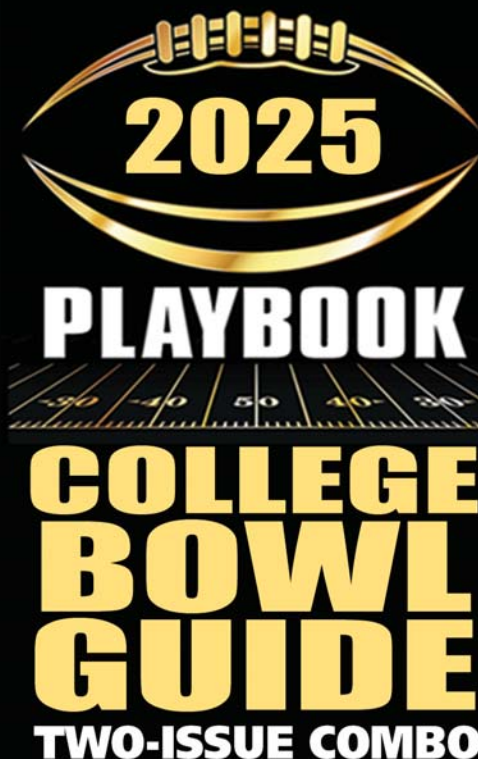

Thursday, December 18

SEATTLE over LA Rams by 7

After winning eight of their last nine games and posting over 500 yards of offense in each of the last two, Los Angeles appears to be the team to beat in the NFC. The Rams, along with the Broncos, are the first teams to secure a playoff spot this season. Davante Adams has a hamstring injury! L.A. fell behind 24-14 with 30 seconds left in the first half but rallied to win the game. It was one of six games where a team trailing by double digits came back to win, setting an NFL record. The concern here is that the Seahawks failed to find the end zone against a battered Colts defense last week. Maybe they were lulled by the sluggish performance of the Colts' reclamation QB Philip Rivers. Or they were focused on this revenge rematch from a 21-19 loss they suffered in L.A. a month ago, despite outgaining the Rams by 165 yards in that game. Yes, Rams' WR Puka Nacua leads the NFL in pass receptions this season with 102, but Seahawks' WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba tops all wide receivers with 1,541 receiving yards. With the Rams off back-to-back games in which they gained 500-plus yards in each game, and **0-4 ATS** in games after facing the Lions, and the Seahawks **3-0-2 ATS** against teams with better than a .750 winning percentage under head coach Mike Macdonald, we're backing Seattle tonight. We seal the deal, noting the Seahawks share in Marc's **AWESOME ANGLE** on page 2.

Saturday, December 13

UPSET GAME OF THE WEEK UPSET

CHICAGO over Green Bay by 4

Big battle for the top spot in the NFC North with 10-4 Chicago currently a half-game ahead of the 9-4-1 Packers with just two weeks remaining after this division showdown. One of the reasons for the Bears' turnaround this season is their ability to dominate the turnover battle, where they rank No. 1 overall in the NFL with a +20 net turnovers, averaging +1.4 per game – or +1.2 more than Green Bay. At the start of the season, Micah Parsons and Patrick Mahomes were widely considered the NFL's best players on their respective sides of the ball. On Sunday, both seasons ended due to torn ACLs, though only Parsons' injury proved devastating to a Packers team that was shaping up to be a Super Bowl contender. On the bright side, the Packers received good news on WR Christian Watkins' shoulder injury, as he may return to the lineup this week. The Bears are seeking revenge after a hard-fought 28-21 loss at Lambeau Field just two weeks ago. With the Bears going **8-1 straight up and against the spread** under head coach Ben Johnson, as well as **6-1-1 ATS** as a home dog coming off a home game, look for the Bears to get the money today. **THE CLINCHER: The Packers are just 2-11 ATS when both teams are coming off non-division games.**

Philadelphia over WASHINGTON by 1

The NFC East seems poised to produce a repeat champion for the first time since 2004, yet the Eagles come across more as the 'least-bad' team in a division full of unremarkable teams. Philadelphia

may stand at 9-5 this season, but it is a shadow of last year's title-winning squad. Making matters worse is Philly's **0-4 ATS** record on Saturdays and their 2-6-1 ATS mark in the previous nine division road games. Meanwhile, the 4-10 Commanders, whose appearance in last year's NFC championship game now feels like a distant memory, counter with a 4-1 ATS record on Saturdays. Head coach Dan Quinn features prominently in this week's **INCREDIBLE STAT** on page 2. Eagles, barely.

Sunday, December 21

Buffalo over CLEVELAND by 6

What can you say? When you're blessed, you're blessed. And Josh Allen's Buffalo Bills have officially been anointed as sanctified this NFL season. It's what happens when you've allowed opponents to score 30 or more four times this season – and gone 4-0 in those games. It opens the door for a disparity in defenses in this matchup, with Buffalo entering with a -29 net yardage differential. The Bills have won three of their last four and remain in the hunt for the AFC East title (trailing the Patriots but with games in hand). A win here could clinch a playoff spot; on the flip side, Cleveland was eliminated from playoff contention after a 31-3 blowout loss to the Bears last week. But stranger things have happened. Cleveland beat Green Bay here as a 7.5-point underdog in September, and they are 2-0 SUATS in games following the Bears. Given Buffy's tendency to play down to the level of opposition (**1-5 ATS** versus .333 or fewer foes, and a **1-5 ATS** mark as road favorites of 6 or more points when coming off a win), it's clothespin time at the Dawg Pound today.

NEW ORLEANS over NY Jets by 3

Some might call this the battle for the No. 1 pick in this year's NFL draft, but many other bad teams are also vying for that 'honor'. In fact, **15 of 32 teams in the league have a losing record** heading into Week Fifteen. The wingless Jets come in with a **1-5-1 ATS** record over their last seven NFC road games. The problem, though, is the Saints' sinister 26-56-1 ATS mark as home chalk against sub .333 opponents, including **1-13 ATS** when coming off a SU underdog win in their last game. Pick your poison.

Minnesota over NY GIANTS by 6

According to Tankathon, Big Blue would hold the No. 1 pick in this year's NFL draft, should they decide to accept it. The burning question, though, is where is Giants interim head coach Mike Kafka headed? According to the NY Post, the NFL had 49 in-season interim head coaches from 2000 to 2024. Of those 49, 34 had never been a full-time head coach before, like Kafka. Eleven were elevated into the job on a full-time basis the following season. Seven later became full-time head coaches after their interim stint did not result in an extension, though four of the seven already had prior head-coach experience. Since Kafka did not, he is trying to beat roughly 8 percent odds. In other words, if the Giants coaching search doesn't land on Kafka – who is 0-4 with three games to go – then he might have to return to life as an offensive coordinator here or elsewhere. Today, however, their focus shifts to Minnesota, where the Vikings look to regroup. They were officially eliminated on December 14, 2025 (during Week 15), when the Chicago Bears' victory over the Cleveland Browns closed off Minnesota's remaining postseason paths. With the table being

set, look to the G-Men to follow orders, and for Minny's **5-1-1 ATS** record in the 2nd of back-to-back travelers, and it's **5-1-1 ATS** mark as non-division road chalk of fewer than 7 points to pave the way to the cashier's window.

New England over BALTIMORE by 1

Pity Mike Vrabel. Like readers of this newsletter, he knew the Bills' rush defense was made of paper mâché and could be run on all day. He designed a rushing attack that focused on exploiting a weak Buffalo run defense – tying their full-game season high for rushing yards in a game (177) in the first half alone and finishing with 246 rushing yards while averaging 9.8 yards per carry. Yet it was not enough when the Pats collapsed like a wet bag, turning a 24-7 halftime lead into a 34-31 heartbreaking loss. A win would have clinched the AFC East. Instead, they've left the AFC East title open for the Bills despite riding a 10-1 outright streak, while on a current **9-0 ITS** (In The Stats) streak entering this game. The **MIDWEEK ALERT** reminds us that if we were to cover up each of the team names with tape in this battle, the Pats would be the favorite in this game based on their overall work this season. Yes, we realize that Baltimore is 23-5 SU from December out during the regular season behind Lamar Jackson, but the fact remains that he is far off his typical MVP-like seasons. With the Black Birds a lackluster **1-5-1 ATS** as a favorite in post-Bengal matchups, we'll lean toward a New England bounce back here.

Tampa Bay over CAROLINA by 6

The Bucs did it again, and so did the Panthers. After their home loss to the Falcons last week, Tampa Bay has a 1-5 SU and 0-6 ATS streak since their Bye week. The Bucs are also 1-9 ITS (In The Stats) in their last ten overall games. Additionally, with their loss at New Orleans last week, Carolina is now 1-12 SU/ATS as a favorite over the past four years. They are also 1-6 ITS in their last seven games. Yes, it's clear that both teams are struggling – yet both remain in the race for the NFC South and the NFL's No. 4 playoff seed. If recent results tell us anything, it's that it's time to stock up on tourniquets. Meanwhile, consider these trends: The Bucs are 5-0-1 ATS after Thursday games, and 6-2 ATS in their last eight division road games; meanwhile, the Panthers are 0-6 ATS against opponents coming off a Thursday game. The trends favor four-time defending NFC South champion Tampa Bay. Remember, these two rivals will meet again in two weeks in Tampa.

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3★ BEST BET

Kansas City over TENNESSEE by 11

It's official, Kansas City will miss the postseason for the first time since 2014 – three years before Patrick Mahomes was drafted and just the second season of Andy Reid's tenure as head coach. Making matters worse, the Chiefs will be without Mahomes for the rest of the season due to a torn ACL. After 10 consecutive trips to the NFL playoffs, including three straight Super Bowl appearances, their 10-season playoff streak was the second-longest in league history – behind only the New England Patriots (2009-19) – and the longest current streak, with the Bills next at six years. Now at 6-8, the Chiefs have already suffered their most losses since 2012, their last losing season (2-14). Incredibly, 7 of their 8 losses this season have been of the one-score variety, after winning each of their previous 16 one-score games. The telling fact, though, is KC's 112-34 record in games Mahomes has started and its 10-8 record in games without Mahomes. Meanwhile, Reid will be 68 next season, older than any coach to have won a Super Bowl. So, right now, while the Chiefs lack much hope for next season, Mahomes might have more opportunities on the back nine of his career. Nevertheless, the self-induced coma that Tennessee plays under, coupled with the Titans' **2-15 ATS** record when coming off an away NFC opponent, prevents us from making a rash decision. Remember, Reid has a 26-9 ATS away record in his NFL career in games where his team is sporting a losing record. Don't be shy. This is the fewest points that Tennessee has received the entire season, and the Chiefs are one of only **THREE** teams in the league that rank in the Top 10 in yardage on both sides of the ball, while Tennessee ranks in the Bottom 10. We seal the deal with **THE CLINCHER: New Chiefs QB Gardner Minshew is 4-0 SUATS on the road in his NFL career when his team is coming off consecutive losses.**

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LA Chargers over DALLAS by 5

Meet the NFL team that garners the least respect in the league this season – the Bolts, aka the L.A. Chargers. Need proof? Justin Herbert's team has been installed as an underdog three times this season. They won all three games outright, including victories over the Chiefs and the Eagles in the past two weeks. You might make it four when they saddle up as dogs against the up-and-down Cowboys at Jerry's Palace in what could be called a Jim Harbaugh special. That's because Harbaugh brings a strong 17-6 ATS record into games against opponents coming off a pair of losses, including **3-0 ATS** when taking points. The Jaw is also 7-3-2 ATS as an underdog against NFC foes. Meanwhile, Cowboys' QB Dak Prescott leads the NFL in passing yards (3,931) this season, but he's also in the Top 10 with INTs, with 10. With Herbert **7-0-1 ATS** when coming off a SU underdog win, we can only focus one way here.

ARIZONA over Atlanta by 1

Both teams are out of playoff contention, making this a play-for-pride, near-season-ending matchup with potential draft implications. Or to put it more succinctly, a showdown between two deeply disappointing 'A' teams looking for the finish line. The Falcons have won 10 of the last 15 games on the scoreboard in this series, while also bringing an 8-4 SUATS mark into this game against the Redbirds when they sport a .666 or fewer win percentage. The problem is they are **2-13 ATS** in games when both teams were taking points in their previous contest. Meanwhile, Zona is the "close-call" king in the league this season, with 7 of its 11 losses by 8 points or fewer. With the Dirty Birds 0-5 ATS against the NFC West, and the Cardinals riding a 7-2 ATS ledger against the NFC South, it's 'red' over 'dirty' in this battle of birds today.

4★ BEST BET

Jacksonville over DENVER by 8

Former No. 1 overall pick Trevor Lawrence has nine touchdown passes and zero interceptions in his past three games for the first-place Jaguars following last year's four-win campaign. With Caleb Williams leading the 10-4 Bears to six wins in the past seven games after a shaky 5-12 rookie season, C.J. Stroud recovering from his sophomore slump and posting a career-high QBR, Bryce Young helping the 7-7 Panthers match their combined win total of the past two seasons, and former Jets bust Sam Darnold shining in Seattle, this seems to be the year of the young QBs' resurgence in the NFL. Heck, even first-round bust J.J. McCarthy has finally shown why Minnesota was willing to move on from Darnold, throwing for a career-high 250 yards with three total touchdowns in a win over the Cowboys. We didn't even mention Broncos QB Bo Nix, who helped vault Denver to the top seed in the AFC Playoff picture. The question today is: which team benefits the most from concurrent win streaks? The Broncos bring an 11-game win streak into this contest – **nine of them one-score victories** – while the visiting Jaguars enter rising on an exact 5-game win streak, knowing NFL underdogs in this role are **15-5 ATS** against foes coming off a win. With that, we turn things over to **THE CLINCHER: NFL teams on an exact 11-game win streak (Broncos) are 5-9 SU and 1-12-1 ATS since 1990 when facing a non-division foe, including 0-7-1 ATS during the regular season... ALERT: teams are 1-12 ATS after facing the Jets this season, but 3-2 outright with a win percentage of .666 or more (Jags).**

5★ BEST BET

DETROIT over Pittsburgh by 16

Both 8-6 teams enter with contrasting results: the Lions – last year's No. 1 seed and currently the No. 8 seed, a game-and-a-half out of the NFC playoff picture—are coming off a loss to the Rams, where they surrendered 519 yards. Meanwhile, the AFC No. 4 seed Steelers won a game that looked more dominating than the 13-point margin against Miami this past Monday night suggests. Adding to Detroit's troubles: they have a revenge game against the Vikings next week, with the Bears on deck afterward. Worse still, they are "leaking oil" like my '51 Plymouth. In other words, this isn't what Dan Campbell's crew signed up for this season. The good news is Lions' QB Jared Goff is **14-3 ATS** in his career after a loss when facing a team coming off a SUATS win, and the men from Detroit are **4-0 ATS** against opponents coming off a Monday night home game. They're also **15-0 SU** and **14-1 ATS** when coming off their last 15 losses. And don't worry about Aaron Rodgers' connection to the Lions from his days with the Packers, where he is currently riding a 0-3 SUATS losing streak and is **0-2 SUATS** all-time as a dog. Add in Mike Tomlin's poor **1-8 ATS** career record against NFC North foes coming off a loss, and suddenly we remember when the 'Ol Plymouth didn't leak oil. We seal the deal with **THE CLINCHER: See this week's TRIVIA TEASER on page 2.**

HOUSTON over Las Vegas by 16

For the second time this season – and in NFL history dating back to 1970 – the "Raiders-of-the-lost-art" failed to gain 100 yards in a game. That's an ignominy not many teams like to be saddled with. Safe to say, the Raiders are reeling: **1-7 SU, 2-6 ATS, 0-8 ITS** (In The Stats) in their last eight games, and they find themselves buried deep in the hunt for the No. 1 overall draft pick. On the other side of the field, the Texans have risen as a key contender in the AFC, currently the No. 7 seed in the AFC Playoff Picture. They also boast the No. 1-ranked overall defense in the league. So, the question is whether head coach

DeMeco Ryans can keep his team from falling into the gutter-level of Las Vegas. At just one game ahead of the slumping Colts in the playoff race, and with the Raiders **0-3 ATS** coming off an NFC road game, and 3-7 ATS after an away game, we believe he can.

MIAMI over Cincinnati by 3

Scores can be deceiving, and that's true for both teams in this matchup. Despite running an impressive 71 plays and holding the ball for nearly 40 minutes, the Bengals were shut out 24-0 by division rival Ravens last week, marking their first loss to Baltimore since 2017. In Monday night's game against Pittsburgh, the Dolphins trailed 28-9 late in the fourth quarter before piling up garbage points and yards. BettorDay notes that his 22-for-28, 253-yard performance resulted in a 113 passer rating... and a 12 QBR. Remember, Passer Rating and QBR are different metrics. QBR emphasizes high-leverage plays when the game is in the balance. Tua Tagovailoa padded his stats in garbage time with two fourth-quarter touchdowns that made a 24-3 deficit look more respectable at 28-15. However, it wasn't enough, and he hits the bench this week with a league-high 15 interceptions (all against zone coverage), replaced by Quinn Ewers, who has only appeared once in an NFL game—completing 5-of-8 passes for 53 yards in mop-up duty at Cleveland a month ago. Tagovailoa signed a four-year, \$212.1 million extension in 2024 after leading the NFL in passing yards in 2023, but at \$54M a year, his days in Miami seem numbered. Meanwhile, head coach Mike McDaniel enters this game knowing he is 14-4-1 ATS in his career with the Dolphins against opponents coming off consecutive losses, including an **8-2 ATS** record at home. That trend aligns well with the Bengals' **2-12 ATS** record in games where both teams are coming off SUATS losses. It might look tough, but backing the Tua-less Dolphins against the defensively challenged Bengals is a smart move, especially as the host in this series improves to **7-0 ATS**.

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Monday, December 22

San Francisco over INDIANAPOLIS by 10

While ancient Colts' QB Philip Rivers nearly pulled off a near-impossible close-but-no-cigar loss at Seattle in his debut with the Colts last week, he physically looked like a right-handed version of the late 6-4, 285-lb QB Jared Lorenzen. Still, although a two-point loss to the skyrocketing Seahawks seems good on paper, the fact remains that Indy managed a season-low 215 total yards of offense and only 9 of Rivers' 27 passes traveled more than five yards. Now, just 1-5 in their last six games after starting the season 7-1, they will face the tough Niners, a team that holds a **13-2 ATS** record when coming off consecutive home games against AFC opponents. The Horseshoes' 2-9 ATS mark in games when coming off an SU loss, but an ATS win cements their struggles.

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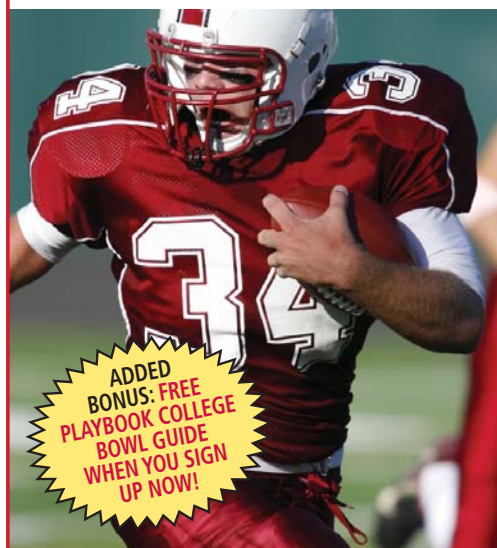
