Way back in 1996 we had our first Thanksgiving Weekend Executive club weekend and had huge success. We priced it at just \$125 and that week there were only 35 College games on that Saturday. This upcoming Thanksgiving weekend there are 67 games and that does not even include Small College (FCS) which were not lined back then. We are superstitious and have kept the price the same each year and last year once again we hit 47-18 72%!! We will NOT discount that price ever as we have kept it at the same \$125 price for 30 years. Almost every Thanksgiving weekend has been a great success thru the years with most hitting 66% or better on the star basis. This past Thanksgiving was a winning weekend but not up to our normal standards. As mentions above we included our College Totals Game of the year in the package (\$100 value) and that play was an easy winner covering by over two TD's. We had a total of 15 star rated plays and they went 8-7 and on the star basis 28-23 56%. We did release 13 marquees which we treat as one star plays and they went 8-5. That makes the final tally for our Thanksgiving Weekend at 36-28 on the star basis for 56.3% which is good and did include a game of the year winner but we are a little disappointed it was not even better. First meeting. This is a battle between the MAC and CUSA Champs. HC Jerry Mack did a phenomenal job turning KSU around. This is their first FBS Bowl game. WMich is making their first trip to the Myrtle Beach Bowl. The Broncos are just 2-8 SU but 5-5 ATS in bowls. Last year was HC Taylor's first bowl and they lost to South Alabama 30-23 (+9).

KSU was picked to finish 11th in the preseason by the CUSA Coaches. HC Mack built the roster with experienced lower level guys and it paid off. They nearly upset Wake Forest in the opener and after an 0-2 start they won 10 of their next 11 games. KSU lost at Jax St in the reg ssn meeting but rebounded and beat them in the CUSA Title game. They are 10-3 SU/ATS but only +2 ypg despite playing our #133 sked. QB Odom has an 18-6 ratio. They have a solid WR corps and a location edge. Their D has allowed 236 (5.7) rush ypg the L4W.

HC Taylor has WMich in a bowl for the first time in 3 years. They were picked to finish 7th in the MAC this year. They started 0-3 and trailed Toledo 13-0 3Q but rallied to win and turned their season around. The Broncos won 9 of their last 10 games including the MAC Title game in a revenge spot vs Miami, OH. WMich has a dominant run game, led by RB Jalen Buckley (829, 4.8) and QB Broc Lowry has rushed for 940 (4.8) and 14 td's. WMich played the #108 sked and are +37 ypg. They've allowed 300 ypg and DE Nadame Tucker has 14.5 sacks. They have the edge in all 3 levels of defense, plus a solid ST's edge (#41 vs #69).

WMich has rushed for 284 (4.5) in their L4 while KSU allowed 236 (5.7) in their L4. The Broncos have the much better D and stronger ST's. HC Taylor will want to win this bowl after LY's close loss. We like the more physical team in WMich, laying just over a fg here for a strong play!

FORECAST: WESTERN MICHIGAN RATING: 4★

First meeting. This game was previously known as the St. Petersburg Bowl and Beef O'Brady's Bowl. Memphis played in the very first version of this bowl in 2008, a 41-14 loss to USF. NC State won here in 2014, 34-27 vs UCF. HC Silverfield left Memphis for Arkansas so DB Cch Reggie Howard is the Interim. NCSt has lost 4 straight bowls and HC Doeren is 3-6 SU/4-5 ATS in bowls.

Memphis was the favorite to win the AAC and considered a playoff contender. They started 6-0 including a win over Arkansas. QB Lewis missed their game at UAB. They were still -21' yet lost 31-24. They rebounded with wins over USF and Rice but fell apart late in the season and lost their last 3. Memphis was +59 ypg and +28 in their L4 despite the 3 losses. QB Lewis has thrown for 2,567 (70%, 15-6) and is their #2 rusher with 613 (4.3). Their best OL, RT Travis Burke missed the finale and is ? here.

NCSt started 3-0 but lost 4 of their next 5 games. They won 3 of their last 4 to finish 7-5. Four of their losses were on the road vs ACC Champs Duke, Notre Dame, Pitt and Miami. They beat GTech, Virginia, FSU and UNC at home, plus had a road win over Wake Forest. NCSt is -26 ypg but played our #33 toughest schedule. The Wolfpack are led by QB CJ Bailey (70%, 2884, 23-9, 215 rush) and RB Hollywood Smothers (939, 5.9). NCSt's Pass Defense is only #90 (63%, 21-8) but they played much better in their last 2 games.

NCSt has played the much tougher schedule (#33 vs #87) and they have a big coaching edge with Dave Doeren against an Interim HC. Memphis has a big edge on ST's (#53 vs #126). We think NCSt will be the more motivated team. Memphis collapsed down the stretch while NCSt won their last two including a 23 point win over rival UNC. The Wolfpack could have some players opt out, including TE Joly and WR Smothers, but we still like them to win the game by more than a touchdown.

OK has had Bama's number in recent history as they've won 5 of the last 6 mtgs. This is a rematch of a week 12 meeting, won by OK 25-23 (+6). Bama actually had a 406-212 yd edge in that game but were -3 TO's including an 87 yd Pick-6 by CB Eli Bowen. LY Oklahoma was +14 and won 24-3. This is HC Venables first playoff trip while HC DeBoer led Washington to the Nat'l Title game in '23.

Bama had a shocking start to their season when they were upset at FSU 31-17. They won their next 8 including at Georgia and beat Vandy and Tennessee at home. After the loss to Oklahoma they were in a must win in the Iron Bowl and squeaked out a 27-20 victory. Bama put up a ssn low 7 pts/209 yards in the SEC Title rematch vs Georgia and lost 28-7. Ty Simpson has a 26-5 ratio but only 5-4 in their last 4 games. RB Jam Miller has been banged up but is expected to return for this game. Their defense allows just 284 ypg and holds foes 88 ypg below their avg. Their ST's is a concern (#74) and K Talty is just 13-20 this year.

We considered Oklahoma a legit playoff contender before the season despite a tough sked. They beat Michigan as part of a 5-0 start. QB Mateer wasn't 100% when they lost 23-6 vs Texas. They allowed a ssn high 34 pts in a loss to Ole Miss then won their last 4 games including road upsets over Tennessee and Bama. QB Mateer hasn't been the playmaker he was expected to be (62%, 12-10, 416 rush). They only rush for 124 (3.7). The Sooners have a typical Venables D, allowing just 274 ypg and holding foes 112 ypg below their avg but the offense put up 10 ypg less than foes allow on avg in SEC play.

Bama has a big edge on offense and they are out for double-revenge. Simpson had success in the first meeting and we think he protects the ball better. Bama won at Georgia so there's no reason they can't win in Norman.

FORECAST: ALABAMA RATING: 2★

First mtg. JMU in the CFP in 4th ssn in FBS. Ducks in postseason 3rd straight yr. They lost to AF (+1) in '23, 31-21, and beat WKU (+7), 27-17. LY HC Bob Chesney took Holy Cross to playoffs from '19-'23. Oregon has missed postseason twice this century ('04 & '16). Ducks lost Rose Bowl (CFP quarters) LY to Ohio St, 41-21. HC Lanning 2-1 SU & 1-2 ATS in the postseason.

JMU 12-1 after winning SBC. Ducks' lost at Louisville in gm they could have won and outscored opp 37-16 (+201ypg). However, their best wins are over ODU & Wazzu, so this is a step up in weight class. Program built on D and ground gm. RB Wayne Knight has rushed for 1,263 (6.6, 379 rec) & QB Alonza Barnett is a dual threat (60%, 21-8, 544 rush). Pass gm 94th and offense struggles when running gm stalls. Offense is good but D is elite. JMU holds opp 137ypg below their avg (#2 FBS!) and have not allowed more than 28pts. Ducks give up 2.5 ypc and 49.5% completions. This is an SBC D playing at P4 level. Chesney is coaching despite taking UCLA job.

Oregon is the highest rated at-large tm. They're also 12-1, only losing to #1 Indiana. At home, Ducks win by avg of 42-14 and 223ypg. QB Dante Moore has had a solid debut with 2,733 yds and 24-6 ratio. His receivers are banged up and the backs are a committee but TE Kenyon Sadiq (490, 12.6) is a star. This is the best D JMU will see all yr. Oregon holds opp 121ypg below their avg (#4 FBS) and gives up 3.2 ypc. The pass D is also solid, ranking #4 with 12-13 ratio. There are no areas where JMU can exploit Lanning's D. Both Duck coordinators have taken HC jobs but will coach in the CFP.

JMU is a great story, but Oregon at Autzen is out of their league. Ducks will stack the box to stop Knight & Barnett and from there it'll be lights out for the offense. Oregon holds edge in every checklist category. JMU D will keep things from getting from out of control for a quarter, but the Ducks will overpower the Ducks in a rout.

FORECAST: OREGON RATING: 2★

Former SEC rivals have played 72 times. Ole Miss has won 12 straight and covered 3 straight incl Wk 4 this yr. First CFP gm for both. This is Ole Miss' 6th straight yr in postseason (3-2 SU & ATS) but 1st gm as HC for Pete Golding. Since '18, Tulane has only missed postseason in '21. HC Jon Sumrall 1-1 SU & ATS in bowls, losing LY to Florida, 33-8, who he'll be coaching in '26.

Tulane is riding its best 4-yr run in program history. Sumrall has maintained what Willie Fritz built from '16-'23. Green Wave 11-2 and slowed UNT for their 2nd American title since '22. They lost at UTSA who almost never loses at home but also lost to Ole Miss, 45-10. They were outgained by 266yds and the QBs were 10-29 for 104 yds. Tulane has beaten NWW, Duke & UNT but those were in New Orleans. QB Jake Retzlaff (62%, 14-6, 610 rush) is an avg passer, so the run gm must produce for the offense to be effective. Tulane's strength is the D. They hold opp 31ypg below avg (#43 FBS), allow 3.5 ypc, and lead the league with 34 sacks.

At 11-1, Ole Miss is having its best ssn ever, but they no longer have their architect, Lane Kiffin, who left for LSU. Golding was DC for 3 yrs and previously was Bama's DC. Rebs' only loss was at Georgia, 43-35, in gm they were outgained 510-351. Their best win was at #8 Oklahoma. At home, Ole Miss +23ppg and +233ypg. Offense gains 142ypg above opp avg (#1 FBS!) led by QB Trinidad Chambliss (66%, 18-3) and RB Kewan Lacy (1279, 5.0). Chambliss led D2 Ferris St to NC so he knows playoff stakes. D can be beaten but it takes a balanced attack which Tulane does not have. Rebs softer against the run (4.3 ypc) than the pass (182 ypg, 13-7 ratio).

Will the Rebels miss Kiffin? Yes. But this gm is about making a statement to the coach that left them. Ole Miss will be fired up, espec on D against 1-dimensional Tulane. Green Wave D will play better than first mtg so we like the under.

WKU has won all 4 mtgs from '12-'20. WKU has bowled all 6 yrs under HC Tyson Helton. They're 4-2 SU & 3-3 ATS incl a 44-23 New Orleans Bowl win over So Alabama (-3') in '22. Southern Miss bowling for 1st time since '22. Blake Anderson has replaced Charles Huff (Memphis) as HC. He was Huff's OC. Anderson 3-6 SU & ATS in bowls and coached Arkansas St to New Orleans Bowl loss in '15.

Helton is 56-36 here but has yet to win CUSA title. This yr's 8-4 tm (9-3 ATS) had new look incl just 2 returning starters on D. Hilltoppers went 3-1 in non-conf and won their 1st 2 CUSA gms before being stunned by FIU (+10) in gm QB Maverick McIvor threw 3 INT's then was lost to inj. He hasn't played since. WKU rallied for 3 wins and only lost at LSU by 3, but lost a 37-34 heartbreaker to Jax St to miss league title berth. Frosh Rodney Tisdale stepped in at QB and flashed with 1367 yds and 9-6 ratio. However, the offense gains just 10 ypg above opp avg (#72 FBS). D is a much bigger issue, allowing 5.1 ypc and lacking havoc with just 16 sacks and 13 takeaways.

Huff led USM to a 6-win improvement before taking Memphis job. However, Eagles crumbled with 3 late losses (0-4 ATS in Nov) to squander shot at SBC title gm. QB Braylon Braxton (65%, 23-7) missed 1st loss but he started next 2 losses. The D fell apart with 4 straight gms over 400 yds allowed and allows 30 ypg above opp avg (#99 FBS). USM's best win is over CUSA's Jax St, 42-25. Unlike WKU, Eagles create defensive chaos with 26 sacks & 26 TO's (#1 FBS with 21 INT's!). Six diff Eagles have multiple picks while WKU has turned it over 18 times to rank 96th in the FBS.

Anderson is a veteran HC so there'll be little dropoff for USM. In fact, his players are motivated since this will be treated like the start of '26 ssn. Braxton is full strength, and Tisdale vs the pick-happy USM DB's favors the Eagles. USM will win the line of scrimmage on D and has a 1.5 edge on the checklist to fuel the upset.

FORECAST: SO MISS (+) RATING: 2★

UNLV won only prior mtg in '88. This is Rebels' 3rd straight bowl. They beat Cal (+3'), 24-13, in LY's LA Bowl. HC Dan Mullen was 7-3 SU & 4-6 ATS in bowls at Miss St and Fla. This is Ohio's 4th bowl in a row. Bobcats have won 6 straight dating back to '17 and are 5-1 ATS those gms! This is John Hauser's debut as interim HC.

Mullen has done a good job of maintaining what Barry Odom built in Vegas. Despite a retooled roster, Rebels are 10-3 (7-6 ATS) and made it to the MWC title gm. They were smoke and mirrors for a while, getting outgained 6 of first 8 gms, but gelled in November. Before losing to Boise, UNLV had won 4 straight by 22ppg and the maligned D improved. QB Anthony Colandrea is the face of the program, throwing for 3275 (66%, 23-8, 621 rush). Skill guys include big-play RB Jai'Den Thomas (985, 7/2) and WR Jaden Bradley (869, 16, 1). While the off avg 36ppg and 79ypg above opp avg (#17 FBS) the D allows 53ypg above opp avg (#122 FBS). They allow 5.3 ypc and have given up 23 td passes but were better in 2H of the yr.

After winning their 1st MAC title since 1968, Ohio missed making the league champ gm this yr. New HC Brian Smith went 8-4 (6-6 ATS) but finished 1-4 ATS down the stretch incl a pivotal 17-13 loss at eventual champ WMU. Earlier this month, Smith took a leave of absence so DC Hauser will coach here. Bobcats beat WV & Miami OH, and all 4 losses came on the road. They've used a familiar blueprint of ground gm and D. QB Parker Navarro is a dual-threat senior (61%, 14-10, 839 rush) and Sieh Bangura leads the MAC with 1243 yds (5.6). The D only allows 23ppg but is much more vulnerable than in '24, allowing 4.4 ypc and 64% through the air.

Smith is out but Ohio's rock-solid culture will overcome the loss. Plus, the Bobcats are tough to beat in bowl gms. They'll control the tempo on the ground with Navarro & Bangura which will frustrate UNLV. Ohio makes it 7 straight in bowls with outright win as a dog.

FORECAST: OHIO (+) RATING: 3★

Cal won last mtg, 51-31, in Australia in '16. Nick Rolovich, a former Hawaii QB making his Warrior debut as HC in Sydney, is Cal's interim HC here. He coached in 3 Hawaii Bowls, going 2-1 SU & ATS. He and Hawaii HC Timmy Chang were teammates. This is Hawaii's first bowl gm since '20 New Mexico Bowl win over Houston

This is Chang's best tm and they played like it, going 8-4 SU & ATS. In Honolulu, they're 6-1 SU & ATS and +15ppg and +103ypg. Warriors already have an ACC win, beating Cal's rival Stanford in the opener 23-20. They also tagged San Diego St with 38 pts when the Aztec D looked unbeatable. QB Micah Alejado had a breakout 1st ssn as the starter with 2832 yds and a 21-9 ratio. After he returned from inj, UH gained more yds than opp avg in 7 of final 8 gms. Top WR Kendrick Harris has opted out so others must step up. The D only allows 15ppg at home and both lines are better than Cal's units.

Another mediocre ssn was enough to fire Justin Wilcox after 9 yrs. Cal is 7-5 SU & 5-7 ATS. Bears started 3-0 then never won b2b gms. In common opp, they lost to Stanford & SD St by 65-10 while Hawaii beat both 61-26. The bright spot was frosh QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele who grew up 20 mi from UH. He threw for 3117 (64%, 17-9) and will return in '26. In road gms, Cal is 3-3 and -6ppg and -9ypg. In their worst losses, TO's were an issue. Bears last in FBS rushing so this will be a battle of young lefty QB's, JKS vs Alejado. Defense, long a staple under Wilcox, went south this yr. Cal allows 13ypg more than opp avg (#81 FBS) and was 13th in ACC sacks and 11th in TO's. They do have the better pass D (#37 vs #59).

This one matters to the Cal coach and QB who have deep Hawaii ties. And the checklist shows the personnel matches up well with Hawaii. But the Warriors are a different at home (17-5-2 ATS since '20 as a home dog) and common opp comparison is telling. Alejado outduels JKS in a higher scoring showcase of the passing attacks.

4★ Cincinnati over MIAMI — CIN was shut out LW in a 24-0 loss to BAL, a game where QB Joe Burrow threw for 225 yds with 2 INTs while WR Ja'Marr Chase still produced 10-132 in a loss driven by turnovers and red-zone failures. That sets up a strong rebound angle: teams shut out in their previous game are 35-17 ATS since 2015 and 5-0 ATS this season, and CIN is also 7-3-1 ATS since 2020 following matchups vs PIT or BAL. MIA looked like it gave up on MNF at PIT, losing 28-15 as QB Tua Tagovailoa threw for 253 yds with 2 TDs but a momentum-swinging INT flipped the game and the offense stalled the rest of the night. With MIA now 1-4 ATS in its last 5 following an ATS win and HC McDaniel sitting 3-10 SU and 1-7 SU as a dog on short rest, this profiles as a spot where Burrow should be able to attack and create separation. **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 13**

3★ DENVER over Jacksonville — DEN has quietly turned its home slate into a separator, remaining unbeaten SU at home and going 6-1 SU/ATS in B2B home games, with non-div home wins coming by an avg of 12.4 points. That showed LW vs GB as QB Bo Nix threw for 302 yds and 4 TD and WR Courtland Sutton posted 7-113-1. JAX arrives off a gaudy offensive performance, led by QB Trevor Lawrence (330 pass yds, 5 TD, plus 51 rush yds and a TD) and RB Travis Etienne (73 rec yds, 3 TD), but that production now steps into altitude and a much steeper defensive environment. JAX has had a cake schedule recently inflating their numbers. DEN is 4-0 ATS vs winning teams and they'll roll here. **FORECAST: Denver by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ DALLAS by 14 over LA Chargers — Dallas wasted yards but not opportunity last week, finishing with QB Dak Prescott at 294 pass yds and WR CeeDee Lamb at 6-111 in a 34-26 loss vs MIN that stalled repeatedly inside the red zone. That inefficiency historically corrects at home, where DAL is 6-0 ATS vs winning teams (4-0 TY) and Prescott is 15-4 SU / 11-8 ATS on homestands, including 3-0 SU following night games. The Chargers survived KC 16-13 behind late defensive plays, as QB Justin Herbert threw for 210 yds (1 TD, 1 INT) and LAC sealed it with 2 fourth-quarter INTs, but that profile hasn't traveled well with LAC 1-4 ATS in its last 5 road games. Dallas scoring environments continue to expand, with the Over 5-1 after SU losses and 8-2 vs winning teams, and with elimination likely looming via a PHI win Saturday, this sets up as a loose, aggressive Dallas offense playing with nothing to protect. **FORECAST: DALLAS by 14**

OTHER PLAYS

LA Rams @ SEATTLE — TNF — LAR comes off a 41-34 win vs DET where QB Matthew Stafford threw for 368 yds (2 TD, 1 INT), RB Kyren Williams rushed for 78 yds with 2 TDs, and WR Puka Nacua posted 9-181 in a second-half surge. SEA edged IND 18-16 as QB Sam Darnold threw for 271 yds, RB Zach Charbonnet was held to 31 rush yds, and WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba went 7-113 while Seattle relied on 6 FG to close it out. LAR has controlled this matchup under McVay, including multiple road covers in Seattle, but SEA has quietly covered 5 straight vs NFC opponents and remains efficient defensively at home. The H2H total has favored the under (5-1) but these offenses are more explosive than the past. However, the rain and high winds expected, these explosive offenses may be tied down.

Philadelphia by 7 over WASHINGTON — Saturday — PHI comes off a 31-0 win vs LV where QB Jalen Hurts threw for 175 yds and 3 TD, RB Saquon Barkley added 78 rush yds and a TD, and TE Dallas Goedert finished with 6-70 and 2 TD as the Eagles controlled the game wire to wire. WAS snapped its skid with a 29-21 win at NYG behind QB Marcus Mariota (211 pass yds, 1 TD), RB Jacory Croskey-Merritt (18-96-1), and WR Terry McLaurin (3-69-1), but that came with short fields and a punt-return TD doing heavy lifting. This matchup has leaned high-scoring in this building, with the Over 7-0 in WAS home games vs winning road teams and 10-1 in WAS Saturday games, while PHI has been inconsistent ATS in December and after big wins. With WAS still leaking yards on D and PHI's offense trending healthier, the setup points toward pace and points even if both sides bring some volatility.

CHICAGO by 2 over Green Bay — Saturday — GB lost in a heartbreaker 34-26 at DEN where QB Jordan Love threw for 276 yds with 2 INTs, while RB Josh Jacobs added 73 rush yds and a TD before turnovers flipped the game after halftime, a poor setup historically with teams on short rest after Denver 5-15 ATS since 2003. It doesn't help the GB caught the injury bug, EDGE Parsons is out for the year and WR Watson may not play. CHI rolled CLE 31-3 behind QB Caleb Williams (242 pass yds, 2 TD), RB D'Andre Swift (18-98-2), and a defense that forced 3 INTs, extending a profile that's 5-1 ATS vs teams with winning records. The matchup brings conflicting divisional signals, with GB 4-0 ATS vs NFC North but 0-5 ATS following SU losses, while CHI is 0-4 ATS on Saturdays and 4-13-2 ATS at home vs NFC North since 2019. Scoring trends point higher, with the Over 6-0 in GB's last 6 road games and Over 5-1 in CHI's last 6 vs NFC North. This matchup should get loose and CHI should sneak in the win here.

Tampa Bay by 3 over CAROLINA — TB QB Baker Mayfield is working with a healthy team again but ultimately lost LW 29-28 vs ATL. Baker threw for 277 yds (2 TD, 1 INT) and WR Mike Evans went 6-132, but late defensive breakdowns erased a 14-point 4Q lead and extended a 0-6 ATS skid. The road profile still matters here, as Mayfield is 23-15 ATS on the road (10-4 ATS with TB) and 5-0 SU vs CAR, winning those matchups by 11.0 PPG, while Tampa Bay enters this spot healthier across the skill positions and OL than it has been for most of the season. CAR dropped a 20-17 loss at NO despite controlling much of the game, with QB Bryce Young held to 163 pass yds (1 TD) and late defensive lapses flipping the result. Carolina has responded well in bounce-back spots (6-0 ATS after SU losses; 5-0 ATS after ATS losses), while scoring trends remain elevated with the Over 5-0 in TB's last 5 December games and 8-2 in CAR's last 10 at home.

Buffalo by 7 over CLEVELAND — The Bills needed a massive second-half surge to escape New England, flipping a 21-0 home behind QB Josh Allen (193 pass yds, 3 TD) while RB James Cook took over on the ground with 22-107-2 and WR Khalil Shakir chipped in 5-65. Those comeback wins have historically been tough to build on, and BUF has shown vulnerability in these spots, struggling ATS against sub-.500 teams and on the road versus losing home records. Cleveland offered little resistance last week in a 31-3 loss at CHI, as QB Shedeur Sanders threw 3 INT on 177 pass yds and WR Isaiah Bond accounted for most of the passing output with just 2 catches for 89 yds while drives repeatedly stalled. With high winds expected and Buffalo coming off an emotional divisional rally, the gap looks narrower than the number suggests even if the Bills still control the outcome.

NEW ORLEANS by 10 over NY Jets — NYJ struggled LW on a 48-20 loss at JAX where QB Brady Cook threw for 176 yds with 3 INT, RB Isaiah Davis went 9-58-1, and WR Adonai Mitchell finished 6-58-1 as the Jets were buried by a 31-point first half. That defense has now gone 14 games without an interception, is 0-4 ATS in December, and continues to struggle generating stops or short fields. NO rallied past CAR 20-17 behind QB Tyler Shough (272 pass yds, 1 TD), WR Chris Olave (6-85-1), and late execution, and the Saints have now allowed under 200 pass yds in 4 straight games, a profile that has gone 7-0 SU in the following game. With NO 4-1 ATS in its last 5, 10-4 to the Under this season, and NYJ consistently failing to capitalize on defensive opportunities, this sets up as a controlled Saints win under the total.

NY GIANTS by 3 over Minnesota — NYG couldn't get it down LW where they lost 29-21 vs WAS and QB Jaxson Dart threw for 246 yds with 2 TD and 1 INT, RB Tyrone Tracy added 70 rush yds and a TD, and TE Theo Johnson finished with 72 rec yds, but special-teams mistakes and a pre-half turnover swung the game. Minnesota enters off a 34-26 win at DAL where QB J.J. McCarthy threw for 250 yds and 2 TD, while the Vikings' defense forced field goals, but that spot has been a poor follow-up historically with MIN 1-5 ATS after SU wins and 1-5 ATS after ATS wins, plus this marks B2B road games. The situational setup favors the home side, with teams on 6-game losing streaks as home dogs vs sub-.500 opponents 51-34 ATS since 2003, while NYG scoring has trended up with the Over 4-0 overall and 4-0 at home. With the Giants moving the ball more consistently and Minnesota in a negative follow-up spot, this profiles as a home bounce-back where NYG finishes late.

Kansas City by 7 over TENNESSEE — KC has been eliminated from the playoffs and comes off a 16-13 loss vs LAC where QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 189 yds with 1 INT before exiting late, TE Travis Kelce led the offense with 7-70, and RB Isiah Pacheco was held to 21 rush yds as scoring chances dried up. With Mahomes now out, QB Gardner Minshew will start the remainder of the season. TEN dropped a 37-24 loss at SF despite RB Tony Pollard rushing for 104 yds and a TD, QB Cameron Ward throwing for 170 yds and 2 TD, and TE Gunnar Haddad adding 4-49-1, but the Titans were outscored early and never seriously threatened. Tennessee has now lost 11 straight SU/ATS following an outright win and sits squarely in

position for the No. 1 overall pick, pointing toward a spot where motivation and execution continue to lag.

Atlanta by 3 over ARIZONA — ATL narrowly beat TB 29-28 where QB Kirk Cousins threw for 373 yds and 3 TD, TE Kyle Pitts exploded for 11-166-3, and RB Bijan Robinson added 93 rush yds and a TD in a game Atlanta stole late despite repeated mistakes. That result puts the Falcons in a historically poor follow-up spot, as ATL is 11-24-1 ATS after SU wins since 2020 and Cousins is 33-46-2 ATS following SU wins in his career, even with ATL 4-1 ATS in its last 5 road games. ARI dropped a 40-20 loss at HOU where QB Jacoby Brissett threw for 249 yds with 3 TD and 1 INT, TE Trey McBride went 12-134-2, and the Cardinals were buried early before playing catch-up the rest of the afternoon. Arizona remains live at home despite recent struggles, with 8-1 ATS in its last 9 home games vs teams with losing road records and home dogs on long SU skids covering at a strong historical rate, keeping this one tight even if Atlanta finishes the job late.

DETROIT by 3 over Pittsburgh — PIT QB Aaron Rodgers dominated on Monday with a 28-15 win vs MIA where he threw for 224 yds and 2 TD, RB Kenneth Gainwell rushed for 80 yds, and WR DK Metcalf added a TD as the Steelers pulled away after halftime. DET dropped a 41-34 loss at LAR despite QB Jared Goff throwing for 338 yds and 3 TD and WR Amon-Ra St. Brown posting 13-164-2, with the Lions allowing explosive plays after halftime. Detroit historically responds in this spot, with Dan Campbell 23-9 ATS off SU losses (14-1 ATS since Nov 2022), and scoring trends stay elevated with the Over 4-0 in DET's last 4 games and 13-3 in the last 16 following an ATS loss, aligning with a fast indoor environment. With Rodgers back in familiar territory and PIT D susceptible to big plays this aligns well with the over and a tighter game where PIT covers.

HOUSTON by 21 over Las Vegas — LV is riding the struggle bus into a matchup with the league's top-ranked D this week, an offense that was completely blanked in Philadelphia and never found rhythm. QB Kenny Pickett finished with just 64 pass yds and an INT, RB Ashton Jeanty was bottled up for 35 yds on 9 carries, and even safety-valve TE Brock Bowers was limited to short-area work (6-28) as the Raiders failed to sustain a drive. That performance extended an 8-game SU skid, and now LV heads back on the road again with QB Geno Smith doubtful and the unit still averaging only 14.0 PPG on the season. Houston, meanwhile, dictated terms against ARI, striking on its first five possessions behind QB C.J. Stroud (260 pass yds, 3 TD), a breakout effort from RB Jawhar Jordan (15-101), and chunk plays from WR Nico Collins (3-85-2), finishing with just one punt all afternoon. With HOU winning 6 straight SU, covering 4 straight ATS, and continuing to suffocate inefficient offenses, this profiles as a spot where control builds early and separation follows indoors.

New England @ BALTIMORE — SNF — NE saw a 21-0 lead disappear in a 35-31 loss vs BUF, with QB Drake Maye finishing with 155 pass yds and an INT while RB TreVeyon Henderson carried the offense early with 148 rush yds and 2 TD. That spot has produced strong responses under Mike Vrabel, as NE is 4-0 ATS following ATS losses and 3-0 SU/ATS in night games this season. BAL countered with its best defensive effort of the year, blanking CIN 24-0 behind RB Derrick Henry (11-100) and a unit that forced multiple takeaways as QB Lamar Jackson accounted for 2 TD. With NE reliable on the road and BAL leaning on defense and the run, this shapes up as a primetime game where execution outweighs form.

San Francisco @ INDIANAPOLIS — MNF — SF rolled TEN 37-24 with QB Brock Purdy throwing for 295 yds and 3 TD, RB Christian McCaffrey adding 73 rush yds and a TD, and the offense scoring TDs on 4 of its first 5 possessions. That efficiency has translated at the window, with SF 4-0 ATS overall, 4-0 ATS after 350+ total yds, and 3-0 SU/ATS in night games this season, though the Niners have failed to cover 4 straight road or neutral games with extended prep. IND dropped an 18-16 decision at SEA as QB Philip Rivers finished with 120 pass yds and an INT while RB Jonathan Taylor carried the offense with 25-87, a setup that historically hasn't held up well as the Colts are 1-4 ATS following ATS wins and 1-4 ATS on MNF, with Shane Steichen 0-2 SU/ATS in primetime. Totals point towards a higher scoring game, with the Over 9-1-1 in SF's last 11 road games vs winning home teams, 6-1 in IND's last 7 December games, and 4-1 in SF's last 5 in DEC, but can old man Rivers change things? It's a different story in IND this time around.
