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Plenty of Balance in Week 10...

On paper, the OU results of last week's Game 10 action in the NFL were extremely balanced... as HALF of all games went OVER and half went UNDER. But the week still had something for everyone: A handful of games that had 65 or more points scored (especially in the Sunday LATE kicks!), and a handful of games that had 35 or less points scored. If you look at the 'bookend games' (the Thursday nighter and the Monday nighter), your impression would be a an UGLY week overall. Both games had identical 10-7 scores with LOW yardage totals and poor football. But with that said, the Sunday DAYTIME games did end up going 7-4 OU, wth an average of 52.4 combined PPG.

Week Ten recap:

It's never a good week for the Tipsheet when the lead plays on Page Two go 0-2. That was the case last week in Tipsheet #10. At the very least, our canines once again bailed us out of a BIG hole as Brutus and Tuco ended up going 2-1. The overall record was an unproductive 2-3 with our Tipsheet plays (-3.7 units). The year-todate record now stands at 26 wins - 24 losses... and -1.4 units for the season. On a more POSITIVE note, our King Creole GAMEDAY service once again delivered a WINNER with our 4* GAME of the WEEK. That Best Bet (available at the PlaybookSports.com website last Wednesday) was on 'OVER 47.5 points' in the NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS / TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS game. It took two LATE TD's with less than 2 minutes left in the game, but the bottom line was another Best Bet winner. Our King Creole service has now gone a documented 67% in our 4* and 5* Best Bets so far in this current 2025 season (6-3 ATS). Remember, our TOP Totals Play of the week is NOT in the Tipsheet. It's only available online...

Ravens @ Vikings OVER 49.0 pts. Both teams looked good on offense in the first half, but FIVE of the first six scores in this game were field goals (OVER bettors need TD's not FG's!). BOTH teams bogged down once they got to the Red Zone, and that cost us dearly. Minnesota actually OUT-YARDED the Ravens in this once, which proves they should have had more than just 19 total points.

Bills @ Dolphins OVER 50.0 pts. Our 2nd play on Page Two actually started out GREAT: With the double-digit underdog Dolphins getting out to a 14-0 lead. But alas, even after outstatting Miami, the Bills turned the ball over 3 times on offense. Even a high-scoring 27-point 4th quarter wasn't enough to overcome the big hole. Loser by a TD...

New England Patriots OVER 23.5 pts (Team Total). Tuco's first Team Total was down here in the Sunshine State. And he was on the RIGHT team, as the HOT New England Patriots scored a TD in EVERY quarter and had 435 total yards. Good start for King's Best Friend! San Francisco 49ers UNDER 23.0 pts (Team Total). Tuco's 2nd Team Total also started off great: San Fran had 0 points after 1 quarter and just 7 at the half. But we were VERY disappointed with how the Rams defense played in the 2nd half. A late Niners TD turned a good start into a bad finish.

Eagles @ Packers UNDER 45.0 pts (Monday). The OU pressure was ON for our newest canine (Baby Brutus) in the Monday Nighter... and the handicapping rookie came through like a seasoned PRO. The OU outcome was never in doubt and Brutus earned a brand new doggie squeaky toy.

Bears @ Vikings 'OVER'



There's FIVE Indoor games on the Week 11 NFL schedule, and we're Going HIGH in two of 'em. Both with higher-than-normal OU lines as well. Our first one will be 'OVER the TOTAL' in the NFC North DIVISION game between the **CHICAGO BEARS and MINNESOTA VIKINGS** at 1:00PM ET. Yes, despite a loss last Sunday in the Ravens game... Minnesota will once against be occupying our Top Spot this week. Based on their offensive yardage last week, they SHOULD have scored a lot more than just 19 points. So we'll call this a 'Positive Points REGRESSION' week for the host Vikings (still tied with Cincy as the #1 OVER team in the league). Things are favorable for the visiting Bears as well. Don't forget that Chicago ROAD games have gone 4-0-1 OU TY, averaging a whopping 61.1 combined PPG (compared to only 44.9 at home). The first database query that I ran for this one is based on the fact that both of these teams went UNDER the Total last week. 16-2 OU last 5 years: All NFC home teams with a high OU line of 47.0 > pts when BOTH teams

are off an 'Under' last week (VIKINGS and BEARS)... Next up, a couple of queries that apply to INDOOR games. (1) 8-1-1 OU last 3 years: All samedivision DOME games with a HIGH OU line of 48.0 or higher (VIKINGS / BEARS)... (2) 11-1 OU last 2 years: All favorites in the 2nd of back-to-back DOME games (VIKINGS), when the OU line is 44.0 or higher... Last week, Minnesota was a mid-ranged home DOG vs the Ravens. This week, they're a slight home fav. 8-1 OU last 4 years: All NFL home favorites who were home DOGS of +4 > pts the previous week (VIKINGS)... Minnesota is 4-5 SU on the year (.444) while Chicago is 6-3 SU (.667). 15-3 OU s'2018: All < .500 NFC home favs (MIN) versus any .666 or better opponent (CHI), when the OU line is > 42.0 points... The visiting Bears are averaging a high 5.0 yards per rush on the season, while allowing a high 5.3 yards per rush on defense. Those numbers set up our last database query: 15-3-1 OU last 6 years: All NFL road dogs of +2 > pts who average 5.0 YPR on offense and ALLOW 5.0 > YPR on defense (CHIC), when the OU line is < 52.0 points.

it's an NFC West Division battle in Sunday's late-kickoffs (4:05pm ET). Our call will be on 'OVER the TOTAL' in the game between the SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS and ARIZONA CARDINALS. Both teams are off horrific defensive games (42 and 44 points allowed), but still scored a respectable 22 points each against two GREAT defenses (vs Rams and vs Seahawks). You saw the results of those NFC West games (66 and 68 totals points scored)... so we'll play for yet another NFC West Division OVER in Week 11. Obviously, we're hoping that QB Brock Purdy is back this week. But either way (Jones OR Purdy), we've got enough database 'ammo' to justify a 2** Play. Like our Bears @ Vikings game, this one is also an Indoor game with a high Total (opened at 47.0 / up to 49.0 as of Tuesday). so THIS query also applies to this game: 8-1-1 OU last 3 years: All same-division DOME games with a HIGH OU line of 48.0 or higher (49ERS @ CARDINALS)... The first database guery that I ran for this one is based on the fact that both of these teams allowed

For our next play, it's another Indoor game in Week 11. In this case, a TON of points last week. 10-0 OU s'2012: All Same-DIVISION games when BOTH teams allowed 38 > pts last week (CARDS vs NINERS), and the OU line is 43.0 or higher... The Cards lost by 22 points last week while the Niners lost by 16 points. 9-1 OU s'2019: All GAME 16 < home DOGS of +2 > pts (CARDS vs NINERS), when BOTH teams are off a big loss of 15 > pts last week, and the OU line is > 37.0 points... Last week, the host Seahawks ran ALL OVER the Cardinals (pun intended), with 198 rushing yards. So far THIS year, NFL teams who allowed 190 > rushing yards on the ROAD have gone 9-1-1 OU in their next game (CARDINALS)... Speaking of rushing numbers, the 49ers are very WEAK in that department this season. Chiefs @ Broncos

Baby Brutus is off a BEAUTIFUL Monday Night WINNER (Eagles / Packers UNDER) in which the Total was pretty much NEVER in doubt. With that said, in Week 11... our newest canine is going <u>UNDER the TOTAL</u> in the Sunday late-afternoon AFC West Division game between the <u>Kansas City Chiefs and</u> **DENVER BRONCOS** in Sunday's late kicks. I got my bet in at a line of 45.5. MAKE SURE you can get in at 44.5 or higher... Brutus wants no piece of the Over on this one. Especially when you factor in that it's a Chiefs / Broncos SERIES that has gone a perfect 0-4 OU in the last 4 meetings (averaging only 32.6 combined ppg!)... We've got two very GOOD defenses taking on each other in this game. These two teams are ranked #3 and #4 in SCORING defense on the year (KC allows 17.7 ppg / Den allows only 17.3 ppg). And the Broncos are NUMBER ONE in Red Zone TD scoring percentage to boot (only 37.5% TD's allowed in The Red Zone)... With KC coming in after their Bye, we note that: (1) DIVISION favs of < 8 pts with REST have gone 1-9 OU L5Y... and (2) GAME 11 < teams with REST have gone 3-16 OU L7Y off a SU fav loss (Chiefs)... Yes, Denver is on a multi-game winning streak. Home dogs of < 5 pts off 5 or more WINS in a row (Denver) haver gone 1-9 OU L8Y... Denver has the better W/L percentage (8-2 SU / .800) in this game. 3-15 OU since 2021: All GAME 3 or greater home DOGS with a current winning percentage of .750 or better (Denver)... Sealing the deal is a DEEP DIVE within this partcular division: AFC WEST same-division games have already gone 1-4 OU this season (only 33.6 combined ppg!)... and 2-15 OU in the last 3 years when the OU line is > 42.0 points!

NFL Week Ten OU review / Week 11 OU lines

For the second week in a row, there was 'Total BALANCE' (pun intended) when it came to OU results in Pro Football. Four games had 65 or more combined points while four games had 35 or less points. And the most interesting part was that the week started AND finished with the exact SAME score (Thursday's game was 10 to 7 / Monday's game was 10 to 7!). Only SIX teams (out of 28) had 400 or more offensive yards, while basically DOUBLE that amount (11 teams) had 300 or less offensive yards. With that said, the overall results of Week Ten was once again 7 OVERS... and 7 UNDERS. The average OU line last week was 44.9... the average combined points was 46.2... and the average OU margin was +1.2 ppg. Through ten weeks, NFL games are now at 79-69-1 O/U for the season (53% Overs). The average combined points-per-game for the season now stands at 46.6. Almost a full point-per-game HIGHER than last year's average of 45.8. Here's the average PPG by the week along with the average MARGIN in parenthesis: Week One 41.3 (-4.2)... Week Two 49.8 (+5.0)... Week Three 46.2 (+1.2)... Week Four 48.6 (+3.8)... Week Five 49.3 (+4.8)... Week Six 42.1 (-3.5)... Week Seven 45.3 (+0.8)... Week Eight 49.8 (+4.4)... Week Nine 48.7 (+1.2)... and Week 10: 46.1 (+1.2).

The PRIMETIME games (night) went 0-3 OU last week (YTD: 15-19-1 OU - 44.8 ppg). ...The THURSDAY game went 0-1 OU (YTD: 5-5 OU - 44.6 ppg).

...FRIDAY games have gone 1-0 OU (48.0 ppg).

...The SUNDAY NIGHT game went 0-1 OU (YTD: 4-6 OU - 48.7 ppg).

...and the MONDAY NIGHT game went 0-1 OU (YTD: 5-8-1 OU - 41.9 ppg).

POWER RATINGS COMPUTATION

Compute the point difference between the home and away team. Multiply that number times 66%. The resulting number should be SUBTRACTED from the road team, if their OU rating is higher than the home team's rating. The number should be ADDED to the road team if their OU rating is lower than the home team's rating. Example: LA CHARGERS (39.7) @ DETROIT (54.0). The difference is 14.3 points. Multiply that number times .666 and the result is 9.5 points. Round off if needed. Add 9.5 pts to the road team (39.7) rating to get a 'suggested' OU Power Rating of 49.2 for this game.

Getting into the RED ZONE. Once an offense gets there, it can result in 7 pts (TD)... or 3 pts (FG)... or 0 pts (turning the ball over or losing it on downs). The difference between a TD or FG occurring in the Red Zone can sometimes be the difference between an 'OVER' or an 'UNDER' cashing. Here's the home and away TD percentages of teams (on offense and defense) in the Red Zone over the last two seasons. HIGHER percentages (in BOLD) increase the odds of an 'Over' hitting. LOWER percentages tend to lead to more 'Unders'. We'll also update this chart throughout the 2025 season.

And what Tuco REALLY likes is that the 'bar is set relatively LOW' for the Kitty Kats this week. We asking Cincy to score *only* 23 or more points. That's a nice low number considering that (a) Veteran QB Joe Flacco has led Cincy to a scoring average of 32.7 PPG (and 405 offensive yards per game) since he was acquired from Cleveland... (b) Cincinnati is 6-3 OU in their Team Totals this year (67% Over)... (c) The Bengals are off a 3-game stretch in which they scored 33, 38, and 42 points..... (d) And one of those games was against this very same Steelers squad (won 33-31 on Thursday 4 weeks ago). The very same Pittsburgh team that's ranked #27 in Red Zone defense, and DEAD LAST in passing defense (allowing 269.4 passing YPG). The Clincher from the database: NFL teams have averaged 31.8 ppg AFTER their Bye Week when they score 40+points in their last game (BENGALS).



OF THE WEEK

2019 ROOKIE Handicapper of the Year Tuco's 2nd play on the Week 11 schedule takes him out to The West Coast. He'll be on another road team as he plays the *SEATTLE SEAHAWKS* to score *OVER* 23.0 points in their division game versus the LA Rams at 4:05pm ET. Like the Bengals play, the oddsmakers have set a decent LOW bar for Seattle in this game (only 23.0 - 23.5 points). That's a VERY attainable number for the visiting Seahawks. After all, they are one of only THREE teams in the NFL that are averaging *more than* 30 ppg on the season (Indy 32.1 / Det 31.4 / Seat 30.6). Not only that, but quarterback Sam Darnold is the most EFFICIENT signal-caller of the season thus far (77.4 QBR rating). Yes, we know why the line is set relatively LOW in this game for Seattle: Their opponent. The great LA Ram DEFENSE. Allowing only 17.0 points per game on the year. But we're playing AGAINST LA at the right time. The Rams just allowed 26 points and a fantastic game against Mac Jones and the 49ers last week (Jones went 33-36 for 319 yards and a QB rating of 115.7!). We already know that Seattle is 7-2 OU in their Team Totals this season. They are ALSO averaging a very impressive 31.2 ppg when playing IN Domes the last 4 years!
